animating	Giving spirit and vivacity.
begin	Begin to speak or say he began. <i>My property begins with the three maple trees.</i>
beginning	The time at which something is supposed to begin. <i>He left at the beginning of February.</i>
bracing	(of a support) serving to brace a structure. <i>The bracing mountain air.</i>
creation	The action or process of bringing something into existence. <i>Job creation.</i>
creatively	In an original or imaginative way. <i>This article inspires you to think creatively.</i>
creativeness	The ability to create.
emergent	An emergent property. <i>An emergent republic.</i>
emerging	Coming into existence. <i>Established and emerging artists.</i>
fresh	With restored energy. <i>A fresh sheet of paper.</i>
freshly	Newly; recently. <i>Freshly ground black pepper.</i>
freshness	Originality by virtue of being new and surprising. <i>The freshness of the wind with its cooling air.</i>
<u>groundbreaking</u>	The ceremonial breaking of the ground to formally begin a construction project. <i>Groundbreaking research into fertility problems.</i>

<u>imaginative</u>	(used of persons or artifacts) marked by independence and creativity in thought or action. <i>An imaginative use of material.</i>
inaugurate	Mark the beginning or first public use of (an organization or project) with a special event or ceremony. <i>He inaugurated a new policy of trade and exploration.</i>
inchoate	(of an offence, such as incitement or conspiracy) anticipating or preparatory to a further criminal act. <i>A still inchoate democracy.</i>
initially	At the beginning. <i>Initially he thought the new concept was nonsense.</i>
innovative	(of a product, idea, etc.) featuring new methods; advanced and original. <i>Stylistically innovative works.</i>
introduce	Introduce. <i>Measures were introduced to help families with children.</i>
<u>inventive</u>	Marked by independence and creativity in thought or action- Lewis Mumford. <i>Had an inventive turn of mind.</i>
<u>nascent</u>	Being born or beginning. <i>The nascent chicks.</i>
newly	In a new or different manner. <i>Newly raised objections.</i>
<u>novelty</u>	The quality of being new, original, or unusual. <i>A novelty teapot.</i>
recency	A time immediately before the present.
recent	The Holocene epoch. <i>In recent months.</i>
recently	In the recent past. <i>Until recently we had a female doctor.</i>
<u>refreshing</u>	Pleasantly new or different. <i>Common sense of a most refreshing sort.</i>
straightforwardness	The quality of being direct and straightforward. <i>What some people take for rudeness is really straightforwardness.</i>
unconventional	Not based on or conforming to what is generally done or believed. <i>An unconventional marriage.</i>
