<u>congenial</u>	Suitable to your needs- T.L.Peacock. <i>Two congenial spirits united by mutual confidence and reciprocal virtues.</i>
<u>courteous</u>	Exhibiting courtesy and politeness. <i>A courteous young man.</i>
<u>courtesy</u>	A curtsy. <i>He treated the players with courtesy and good humour.</i>
couth	Refined. <i>It is more couth to hold your shrimp genteelly by the tail when eating.</i>
curtsy	Perform a curtsy. <i>She bobbed a curtsy to him.</i>
<u>decent</u>	Decently clothed. <i>A decent burial.</i>

<u>delightful</u>	Greatly pleasing or entertaining. <i>A delightful secluded garden.</i>
<u>friendliness</u>	A feeling of liking for another person; enjoyment in their company. <i>I was overwhelmed by the friendliness of the people here.</i>
friendly	Inclined to help or support; not antagonistic or hostile. <i>An environment friendly agronomic practice.</i>
<u>generosity</u>	Acting generously. <i>Diners certainly cannot complain about the generosity of portions.</i>
goodness	The beneficial or nourishing element of food. <i>A belief in the basic goodness of mankind.</i>
<u>gracious</u>	A polite epithet used of royalty or their acts. <i>Thanks to the gracious gods.</i>
humbleness	The state of being humble and unimportant.
innocuous	Not injurious to physical or mental health. <i>Confined himself to innocuous generalities.</i>
intriguing	Disturbingly provocative. <i>An intriguing smile.</i>
<u>kindly</u>	Showing or motivated by sympathy and understanding and generosity. <i>Would you kindly explain what you re talking about.</i>
kindness	The quality of being friendly, generous, and considerate. <i>It would be a kindness on your part to invite her.</i>
<u>pleasant</u>	(of a person or their manner) friendly and considerate; likeable. <i>A pleasant scene.</i>
pleasantness	The quality of giving pleasure. <i>The pleasantness of a cool breeze on a hot summer day.</i>
<u>polite</u>	Relating to people who regard themselves as more cultured and refined than others. <i>Polite society.</i>
politely	In a respectful and considerate manner. <i>He waited politely for me to ask questions.</i>
respectfully	In a respectful manner. <i>I must respectfully disagree with your claim.</i>
<u>unassuming</u>	Not pretentious or arrogant; modest. <i>He was an unassuming and kindly man.</i>
