<b>couth</b>	Refined. <i>It is more <b>couth</b> to hold your shrimp genteelly by the tail when eating.</i>
<b>curtsy</b>	Perform a curtsy. <i>She bobbed a <b>curtsy</b> to him.</i>

<b><u>delightful</u></b>	Greatly pleasing or entertaining. <i>A <b>delightful</b> secluded garden.</i>
<b><u>friendliness</u></b>	A feeling of liking for another person; enjoyment in their company. <i>I was overwhelmed by the <b>friendliness</b> of the people here.</i>
<b>friendly</b>	Inclined to help or support; not antagonistic or hostile. <i>An environment <b>friendly</b> agronomic practice.</i>
<b><u>generosity</u></b>	Acting generously. <i>Diners certainly cannot complain about the <b>generosity</b> of portions.</i>
<b>goodness</b>	The beneficial or nourishing element of food. <i>A belief in the basic <b>goodness</b> of mankind.</i>
<b><u>gracious</u></b>	A polite epithet used of royalty or their acts. <i>Thanks to the <b>gracious</b> gods.</i>
<b>humbleness</b>	The state of being humble and unimportant.
<b>innocuous</b>	Not injurious to physical or mental health. <i>Confined himself to <b>innocuous</b> generalities.</i>
<b>intriguing</b>	Disturbingly provocative. <i>An <b>intriguing</b> smile.</i>
<b><u>kindly</u></b>	Showing or motivated by sympathy and understanding and generosity. <i>Would you <b>kindly</b> explain what you re talking about.</i>
<b>kindness</b>	The quality of being friendly, generous, and considerate. <i>It would be a <b>kindness</b> on your part to invite her.</i>
<b><u>pleasant</u></b>	(of a person or their manner) friendly and considerate; likeable. <i>A <b>pleasant</b> scene.</i>
<b>pleasantness</b>	The quality of giving pleasure. <i>The <b>pleasantness</b> of a cool breeze on a hot summer day.</i>
<b><u>polite</u></b>	Relating to people who regard themselves as more cultured and refined than others. <i><b>Polite</b> society.</i>
<b>politely</b>	In a respectful and considerate manner. <i>He waited <b>politely</b> for me to ask questions.</i>
<b>respectfully</b>	In a respectful manner. <i>I must <b>respectfully</b> disagree with your claim.</i>
<b><u>unassuming</u></b>	Not pretentious or arrogant; modest. <i>He was an <b>unassuming</b> and kindly man.</i>
