Definitions of "Ninja" as a noun

- A class of 14th century Japanese who were trained in martial arts and were hired for espionage and assassinations.
- A person skilled in the Japanese art of ninjutsu.
- A member of the ninja who were trained in martial arts and hired for espionage or sabotage or assassinations; a person skilled in ninjutsu.
- A person who excels in a particular skill or activity.





Synonyms of "Ninja" as a noun (5 Words)

authority	Persons who exercise (administrative) control over others. A rebellion against those in authority .
oracle	A response or message given by an oracle especially an ambiguous one. <i>He reigned supreme as the Colonial Office s oracle on Africa.</i>
pundit	An expert in a particular subject or field who is frequently called upon to give their opinions to the public. <i>Political pundits were tipping him for promotion.</i>
resource person	A source of aid or support that may be drawn upon when needed.
specialist	A person who concentrates primarily on a particular subject or activity; a person highly skilled in a specific and restricted field. <i>The study was undertaken by a market research specialist.</i>
