Definitions of "Ninja" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “ninja” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A class of 14th century Japanese who were trained in martial arts and were hired for espionage and assassinations.*
- *A person skilled in the Japanese art of ninjutsu.*
- *A member of the ninja who were trained in martial arts and hired for espionage or sabotage or assassinations; a person skilled in ninjutsu.*
- *A person who excels in a particular skill or activity.*



Synonyms of "Ninja" as a noun (5 Words)

- authority** Persons who exercise (administrative) control over others.
*A rebellion against those in **authority**.*
- oracle** A response or message given by an oracle especially an ambiguous one.
*He reigned supreme as the Colonial Office's **oracle** on Africa.*
- pundit** An expert in a particular subject or field who is frequently called upon to give their opinions to the public.
*Political **pundits** were tipping him for promotion.*
- resource person** A source of aid or support that may be drawn upon when needed.
- specialist** A person who concentrates primarily on a particular subject or activity; a person highly skilled in a specific and restricted field.
*The study was undertaken by a market research **specialist**.*



Usage Examples of "Ninja" as a noun
