**ninety** The cardinal number that is the product of ten and nine.

**nothing** In no respect; to no degree.

This is a surprise Surprise **nothing**.

nowhere Having no prospect of progress or success.

The constable was **nowhere** to be seen.

**selected** Chosen in preference to another.

**seventeen** The cardinal number that is the sum of sixteen and one. **sixteen** The cardinal number that is the sum of fifteen and one.

**sixty** Being ten more than fifty.

**somewhere** In or at or to some place someplace is used informally for somewhere.

I ve seen you **somewhere** before.

thirteen The cardinal number that is the sum of twelve and one.thousand The cardinal number that is the product of 10 and 100.

unaided Carried out without aid or assistance.

She can no longer walk unaided.

**undress** Get undressed.
