- *By no amount; not at all.*
- *Not at all or in no way.*

by no means any So as to pass a given point.

in no way To or toward the inside of.

to no extent Used to express refusal or denial or disagreement etc or especially to emphasize a negative statement.

- denude** Lay bare.
*Almost overnight the Arctic was **denuded** of animals.*
- eighteen** Being one more than seventeen.
- eighty** The cardinal number that is the product of ten and eight.
- eleven** The cardinal number that is the sum of ten and one.
- everywhere** To or in any or all places; ('everyplace' is used informally fo.
*He carried a gun **everywhere** he went.*
- exposed** Not covered or hidden; visible.
*The venue featured beautiful hardwood floors and **exposed** brick walls.*
- fifteen** The cardinal number that is the sum of fourteen and one.

fifty	Being ten more than forty.
fortnight	A period of two weeks. <i>Most major tennis tournaments last a fortnight.</i>
fourteen	The cardinal number that is the sum of thirteen and one.
naught	A quantity of no importance. <i>It was all for naught.</i>
nihilist	An advocate of anarchism. <i>It is impossible to argue against a nihilist.</i>
nil	Non-existent. <i>Reduced to nil all the work we had done.</i>
ninety	The cardinal number that is the product of ten and nine.
nothing	In no respect; to no degree. <i>This is a surprise Surprise nothing.</i>
nowhere	Having no prospect of progress or success. <i>The constable was nowhere to be seen.</i>
selected	Chosen in preference to another.
seventeen	The cardinal number that is the sum of sixteen and one.
sixteen	The cardinal number that is the sum of fifteen and one.
sixty	Being ten more than fifty.
somewhere	In or at or to some place someplace is used informally for somewhere. <i>I ve seen you somewhere before.</i>
thirteen	The cardinal number that is the sum of twelve and one.
thousand	The cardinal number that is the product of 10 and 100.
unaided	Carried out without aid or assistance. <i>She can no longer walk unaided.</i>
undress	Get undressed. <i>His undress uniform.</i>
zero	Adjust an instrument or device to zero value. <i>He zeroed in his rifle at 200 yards.</i>
