## Definitions of "Not" as an adverb

- Used in understatements to suggest that the opposite of a following word or phrase is true.
- Following and emphatically negating a statement.
- No more than (used to indicate a surprisingly small quantity.
- Used with a quantifier to exclude a person or part of a group.
- Negation of a word or group of words.
- Used as a short substitute for a negative clause.
- Used in some constructions with other verbs.
- Used to express the negative of other words.
- Used with an auxiliary verb or 'be' to form the negative.
