vegetarian	Relating to vegetarians or vegetarianism. A vegetarian restaurant.
victuals	Any substance that can be used as food.
vitamin	A pill containing a specified amount of a particular vitamin or vitamins taken as a dietary supplement. <i>Vitamin deficiency.</i>
wholesome	Conducive to or characterized by moral well-being. Exercise develops wholesome appetites.
wholesomeness	The quality of being beneficial and generally good for you.
