<b>adorned</b>	Provided with something intended to increase its beauty or distinction.
<b><u>anniversary</u></b>	The date on which a romance began in a previous month or week. <i>The 50th <b>anniversary</b> of the Battle of Britain.</i>
<b>banquet</b>	Provide a feast or banquet for. <i>A <b>banquet</b> for the graduating seniors.</i>
<b>bedeck</b>	Decorate. <i>He led us into a room <b>bedecked</b> with tinsel.</i>
<b>benediction</b>	A ceremonial prayer invoking divine protection. <i>He said the <b>benediction</b>.</i>
<b>betroth</b>	Formally engage (someone) to be married. <i>In no time I shall be <b>betrothed</b> to Isabel.</i>
<b>etrothal</b>	A mutual promise to marry.
<b><u>bouquet</u></b>	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property. <i>The aperitif has a faint <b>bouquet</b> of almonds.</i>
<b>bridal</b>	Of or pertaining to a bride. <i>Her white <b>bridal</b> gown.</i>
<b><u>bride</u></b>	A woman on her wedding day or just before and after the event. <i>The <b>bride</b> and groom left early last night.</i>
<b>bridegroom</b>	A man participant in his own marriage ceremony.
<b>ceremony</b>	A formal religious or public occasion, especially one celebrating a particular event, achievement, or anniversary. <i>The winners were presented with their prizes at a special <b>ceremony</b>.</i>
<b>consummate</b>	Make (a marriage or relationship) complete by having sexual intercourse. <i>They did not <b>consummate</b> their marriage until months after it took place.</i>
<b><u>diamond</u></b>	A transparent piece of diamond that has been cut and polished and is valued as a precious gem. <i>She led a losing <b>diamond</b>.</i>
<b>dowry</b>	Money or property brought by a woman to her husband at marriage. <i>Elizabeth s <b>dowry</b> was to be 45 000 in diamonds.</i>
<b>engagement</b>	A mutual promise to marry. <i>A good long <b>engagement</b> to give you time to be sure.</i>
<b><u>feast</u></b>	Partake in a feast or banquet. <i>A wedding <b>feast</b>.</i>
<b><u>groom</u></b>	A bridegroom. <i>He is <b>grooming</b> his son to become his successor.</i>



<b>headdress</b>	Clothing for the head. <i>A veil held in place with a pearl <b>headdress</b>.</i>
<b>honeymoon</b>	Spend a honeymoon. <i>They flew to the West Indies on <b>honeymoon</b>.</i>
<b><u>jewelry</u></b>	An adornment (as a bracelet or ring or necklace) made of precious metals and set with gems (or imitation gems).
<b>marital</b>	Relating to marriage or the relations between a married couple. <i><b>Marital</b> status.</i>
<b>marriage</b>	The state of being married. <i>A long and happy <b>marriage</b>.</i>
<b>married</b>	A person who is married. <i>A <b>married</b> man.</i>
<b>marry</b>	Blend or combine with something. <i>They had no plans to <b>marry</b>.</i>
<b>newlywed</b>	Someone recently married.
<b>preen</b>	Congratulate or pride oneself. <i>Reed buntings <b>preened</b> at the pool's edge.</i>
<b>troth</b>	Faith or loyalty when pledged in a solemn agreement or undertaking. <i>A token of <b>troth</b>.</i>
<b><u>veil</u></b>	Cover with a veil. <i>The development of these technologies has been <b>veiled</b> in secrecy.</i>
<b>wedding</b>	A party of people at a wedding.
