<u>elevate</u>	(of a priest) hold up (a consecrated host or chalice) for adoration. She ordered the bishop celebrating Mass in her chapel not to elevate the Host.
<u>elevation</u>	(ballet) the height of a dancer's leap or jump. As every gunner knows increasing the elevation beyond five degrees can be a risky business.
engender	Make (offspring) by reproduction. The issue engender ed continuing controversy.
<u>foster</u>	Bring up under fosterage of children. When foster ing out a child placement workers will be looking for a home similar to their own.
hackles	A feeling of anger and animosity. Having one s hackles or dander up.
<u>hoist</u>	An act of raising or lifting something. She hoist ed her backpack on to her shoulder.
housework	Regular work done in housekeeping, especially cleaning and tidying. I was busy doing housework when the doorbell rang.



hybrid	Bred as a hybrid from different species or varieties. Jungle is a hybrid of reggae and house music.
increasing	Music increasing in tempo and or volume. <i>Increasing</i> prices.
institutional	Relating to or constituting or involving an institution. <i>Institutional</i> religion.
mongrel	A person of mixed descent. She s a particularly intelligent mongrel with a lot of collie in her.
mounting	The action of mounting something. <i>He pulled the curtain rail from its mounting.</i>
overindulgence	Excessive gratification of a person's wishes. The child was spoiled by overindulgence .
<u>parent</u>	Be or act as a parent to a child. Stems will root down creating a new crown near the parent .
pregnant	(of a woman or female animal) having a child or young developing in the uterus. A silence pregnant with suspense.
produce	Agricultural and other natural products collectively. The plant produce s blue flowers in late autumn.
propagation	The act of producing offspring or multiplying by such production. <i>The physics of light propagation</i> .
raise	Raise in rank or condition. <i>Raise</i> a mutiny.
raising	Helping someone grow up to be an accepted member of the community. A raising of the land resulting from volcanic activity.
rearing	Rearing on left hind leg with forelegs elevated and head usually in profile.
<u>reproduction</u>	A copy of a work of art, especially a print or photograph of a painting. <i>Toads converge upon lakes and ponds intent on</i> reproduction .
skyrocket	(of a price, rate, or amount) increase very steeply or rapidly. The cost of the welfare system has skyrocket ed.
spawn	The process of producing spawn. A supplier of spawn for shiitake mushrooms.
<u>upbringing</u>	Properties acquired during a person's formative years. <i>He was a countryman by upbringing.</i>
<u>uplift</u>	Lift up from the earth, as by geologic forces. To get our whole group back together should be a big emotional uplift for the team.
