| <a href="#"><u>elevate</u></a>   | (of a priest) hold up (a consecrated host or chalice) for adoration.<br><i>She ordered the bishop celebrating Mass in her chapel not to <b>elevate</b> the Host.</i> |
| <a href="#"><u>elevation</u></a> | (ballet) the height of a dancer's leap or jump.<br><i>As every gunner knows increasing the <b>elevation</b> beyond five degrees can be a risky business.</i>         |
| <b>engender</b>                  | Make (offspring) by reproduction.<br><i>The issue <b>engendered</b> continuing controversy.</i>  |
| <a href="#"><u>foster</u></a>    | Bring up under fosterage of children.<br><i>When <b>fostering</b> out a child placement workers will be looking for a home similar to their own.</i>                 |
| <b>hackles</b>                   | A feeling of anger and animosity.<br><i>Having one's <b>hackles</b> or dander up.</i>  |
| <a href="#"><u>hoist</u></a>     | An act of raising or lifting something.<br><i>She <b>hoisted</b> her backpack on to her shoulder.</i>  |
| <b>housework</b>                 | Regular work done in housekeeping, especially cleaning and tidying.<br><i>I was busy doing <b>housework</b> when the doorbell rang.</i>                              |

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| <b>hybrid</b>              | Bred as a hybrid from different species or varieties.<br><i>Jungle is a <b>hybrid</b> of reggae and house music.</i>                                  |
| <b>increasing</b>          | Music increasing in tempo and or volume.<br><i><b>Increasing</b> prices.</i>  |
| <b>institutional</b>       | Relating to or constituting or involving an institution.<br><i><b>Institutional</b> religion.</i>   |
| <b>mongrel</b>             | A person of mixed descent.<br><i>She s a particularly intelligent <b>mongrel</b> with a lot of collie in her.</i>                                     |
| <b>mounting</b>            | The action of mounting something.<br><i>He pulled the curtain rail from its <b>mounting</b>.</i>  |
| <b>overindulgence</b>      | Excessive gratification of a person's wishes.<br><i>The child was spoiled by <b>overindulgence</b>.</i>   |
| <b><u>parent</u></b>       | Be or act as a parent to a child.<br><i>Stems will root down creating a new crown near the <b>parent</b>.</i>   |
| <b>pregnant</b>            | (of a woman or female animal) having a child or young developing in the uterus.<br><i>A silence <b>pregnant</b> with suspense.</i>                    |
| <b>produce</b>             | Agricultural and other natural products collectively.<br><i>The plant <b>produces</b> blue flowers in late autumn.</i>                                |
| <b>propagation</b>         | The act of producing offspring or multiplying by such production.<br><i>The physics of light <b>propagation</b>.</i>                                  |
| <b>raise</b>               | Raise in rank or condition.<br><i><b>Raise</b> a mutiny.</i>  |
| <b>raising</b>             | Helping someone grow up to be an accepted member of the community.<br><i>A <b>raising</b> of the land resulting from volcanic activity.</i>           |
| <b>rearing</b>             | Rearing on left hind leg with forelegs elevated and head usually in profile.  |
| <b><u>reproduction</u></b> | A copy of a work of art, especially a print or photograph of a painting.<br><i>Toads converge upon lakes and ponds intent on <b>reproduction</b>.</i> |
| <b>skyrocket</b>           | (of a price, rate, or amount) increase very steeply or rapidly.<br><i>The cost of the welfare system has <b>skyrocketed</b>.</i>                      |
| <b>spawn</b>               | The process of producing spawn.<br><i>A supplier of <b>spawn</b> for shiitake mushrooms.</i>  |
| <b><u>upbringing</u></b>   | Properties acquired during a person's formative years.<br><i>He was a countryman by <b>upbringing</b>.</i>  |
| <b><u>uplift</u></b>       | Lift up from the earth, as by geologic forces.<br><i>To get our whole group back together should be a big emotional <b>uplift</b> for the team.</i>   |
