<b>analyze</b>	Make a mathematical, chemical, or grammatical analysis of; break down into components or essential features. <i><b>Analyze</b> a sonnet by Shakespeare.</i>
<b>assortment</b>	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. <i>A great <b>assortment</b> of cars was on display.</i>
<b>categorize</b>	Place into or assign to a category. <i>Children learn early on to <b>categorize</b>.</i>
<b>classification</b>	The basic cognitive process of arranging into classes or categories. <i>New <b>classifications</b> for drivers of commercial vehicles.</i>

<b>different</b>	Distinct or separate. <i><b>Different</b> parts of the country.</i>
<a href="#">dissimilar</a>	Marked by dissimilarity. <i>The pleasures of the romance novel are not <b>dissimilar</b> from those of the chocolate bar.</i>
<a href="#">distinguish</a>	Make oneself worthy of respect by one's behaviour or achievements. <i>The child is perfectly capable of <b>distinguishing</b> reality from fantasy.</i>
<b>diverse</b>	Distinctly dissimilar or unlike. <i>Subjects as <b>diverse</b> as architecture language teaching and the physical sciences.</i>
<b>diversity</b>	The state of being diverse; variety. <i>There was considerable <b>diversity</b> in the style of the reports.</i>
<b>hierarchic</b>	Classified according to various criteria into successive levels or layers. <i>It has been said that only a <b>hierarchic</b> society with a leisure class at the top can produce works of art.</i>
<b>identify</b>	Identify as in botany or biology for example. <i>The judge ordered that the girl should not be identified.</i>

<b>miscellaneous</b>	Having many aspects. A <b>miscellaneous</b> collection of well known ne er do wells.
<b>miscellany</b>	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. A <b>miscellany</b> of houses.
<b>motley</b>	A garment made of motley especially a court jester s costume. A <b>motley</b> crew of discontents and zealots.
<b>multifaceted</b>	Having many sides. A <b>multifaceted</b> undertaking.
<b>multifarious</b>	Having many aspects. <b>Multifarious</b> activities.
<b>multiplicity</b>	The property of being multiple. The demand for higher education depends on a <b>multiplicity</b> of factors.
<b>nomenclature</b>	The term or terms applied to someone or something. Biological <b>nomenclature</b> .
<b>pastiche</b>	An artistic work in a style that imitates that of another work, artist, or period. The operetta is a <b>pastiche</b> of 18th century style.
<b>pigeonhole</b>	Put a document in a pigeonhole. She <b>pigeonholed</b> her worry about him.
<b>pluralism</b>	The practice of holding more than one ecclesiastical office at a time.
<b>potpourri</b>	A mixture of dried petals and spices placed in a bowl to perfume a room. He played a <b>potpourri</b> of tunes from Gilbert and Sullivan.
<b>sorting</b>	An operation that segregates items into groups according to a specified criterion. The bottleneck in mail delivery is the process of <b>sorting</b> .
<b>stratified</b>	Arranged in a sequence of grades or ranks. <b>Stratified</b> areas of the distribution.
<b>taxonomy</b>	(biology) study of the general principles of scientific classification. The <b>taxonomy</b> of these fossils.
<b>type</b>	Metal types used in letterpress printing. Two sporty <b>types</b> in tracksuits.
<b>variety</b>	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. It s the <b>variety</b> that makes my job so enjoyable.
<b>various</b>	Considered individually. His <b>various</b> achievements are impressive.
<b>vary</b>	Make something more diverse and varied. His moods <b>vary</b> depending on the weather.
