analyze	Make a mathematical, chemical, or grammatical analysis of; break down into components or essential features. <i>Analyze a sonnet by Shakespeare.</i>
assortment	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. <i>A great assortment of cars was on display.</i>
categorize	Place into or assign to a category. <i>Children learn early on to categorize.</i>
classification	The basic cognitive process of arranging into classes or categories. <i>New classifications for drivers of commercial vehicles.</i>
classify	Arrange or order by classes or categories. <i>How would you classify these pottery shards are they prehistoric.</i>
different	Distinct or separate. <i>Different parts of the country.</i>
dissimilar	Marked by dissimilarity. <i>The pleasures of the romance novel are not dissimilar from those of the chocolate bar.</i>
distinguish	Make oneself worthy of respect by one's behaviour or achievements. <i>The child is perfectly capable of distinguishing reality from fantasy.</i>
diverse	Distinctly dissimilar or unlike. <i>Subjects as diverse as architecture language teaching and the physical sciences.</i>
diversity	The state of being diverse; variety. <i>There was considerable diversity in the style of the reports.</i>
hierarchic	Classified according to various criteria into successive levels or layers. <i>It has been said that only a hierarchic society with a leisure class at the top can produce works of art.</i>
identify	Identify as in botany or biology for example. <i>The judge ordered that the girl should not be identified.</i>

miscellaneous	Having many aspects. A miscellaneous collection of well known ne er do wells.
miscellany	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. A miscellany of houses.
motley	A garment made of motley especially a court jester s costume. A motley crew of discontents and zealots.
multifaceted	Having many sides. A multifaceted undertaking.
multifarious	Having many aspects. Multifarious activities.
multiplicity	The property of being multiple. The demand for higher education depends on a multiplicity of factors.
nomenclature	The term or terms applied to someone or something. Biological nomenclature .
pastiche	An artistic work in a style that imitates that of another work, artist, or period. The operetta is a pastiche of 18th century style.
pigeonhole	Put a document in a pigeonhole. She pigeonholed her worry about him.
pluralism	The practice of holding more than one ecclesiastical office at a time.
potpourri	A mixture of dried petals and spices placed in a bowl to perfume a room. He played a potpourri of tunes from Gilbert and Sullivan.
sorting	An operation that segregates items into groups according to a specified criterion. The bottleneck in mail delivery is the process of sorting .
stratified	Arranged in a sequence of grades or ranks. Stratified areas of the distribution.
taxonomy	(biology) study of the general principles of scientific classification. The taxonomy of these fossils.
type	Metal types used in letterpress printing. Two sporty types in tracksuits.
variety	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. It s the variety that makes my job so enjoyable.
various	Considered individually. His various achievements are impressive.
vary	Make something more diverse and varied. His moods vary depending on the weather.
