Infinitive	<b>to ok</b>
Present Tense	<b>ok / oks</b>
Past Tense	<b>oked</b>
Present Participle	<b>oking</b>
Past Participle	<b>oked</b>

## Conjugate Ok

**Ok in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>ok</b>	We <b>ok</b>
You <b>ok</b>	You <b>ok</b>
He/She/It <b>oks</b>	They <b>ok</b>

## **Ok in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am oking</b>	We <b>are oking</b>
You <b>are oking</b>	You <b>are oking</b>
He/She/It <b>is oking</b>	They <b>are oking</b>

## **Ok in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have oked</b>	We <b>have oked</b>
You <b>have oked</b>	You <b>have oked</b>
He/She/It <b>has oked</b>	They <b>have oked</b>

## **Ok in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been oking</b>	We <b>have been oking</b>
You <b>have been oking</b>	You <b>have been oking</b>
He/She/It <b>has been oking</b>	They <b>have been oking</b>

## **Ok in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>oked</b>	We <b>oked</b>
You <b>oked</b>	You <b>oked</b>
He/She/It <b>oked</b>	They <b>oked</b>

## **Ok in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>was oking</b>	We <b>were oking</b>
You <b>were oking</b>	You <b>were oking</b>
He/She/It <b>was oking</b>	They <b>were oking</b>

**Ok in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had oked</b>	We <b>had oked</b>
You <b>had oked</b>	You <b>had oked</b>
He/She/It <b>had oked</b>	They <b>had oked</b>

**Ok in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>had been oking</b>	We <b>had been oking</b>
You <b>had been oking</b>	You <b>had been oking</b>
He/She/It <b>had been oking</b>	They <b>had been oking</b>

**Ok in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I <b>will ok</b>	We <b>will ok</b>
You <b>will ok</b>	You <b>will ok</b>
He/She/It <b>will ok</b>	They <b>will ok</b>

**Ok in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I <b>will be oking</b>	We <b>will be oking</b>
You <b>will be oking</b>	You <b>will be oking</b>
He/She/It <b>will be oking</b>	They <b>will be oking</b>

**Ok in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have oked**

**We will have oked**

**You will have oked**

**You will have oked**

**He/She/It will have oked**

**They will have oked**

**Ok in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been oking**

**We will have been oking**

**You will have been oking**

**You will have been oking**

**He/She/It will have been oking**

**They will have been oking**
