Associations of "Once again" (30 Words)

alliteration	The occurrence of the same letter or sound at the beginning of adjacent or closely connected words. <i>The alliteration of sweet birds sang.</i>
biannual	Occurring or payable twice each year. <i>The biannual meeting of the planning committee.</i>
colonnade	A row of trees or other tall objects.
continual	Continual meaning seemingly uninterrupted is often used interchangeably with continuous meaning without interruption. <i>Continual is often used interchangeably with continuous.</i>
daily	Every day; without missing a day. <i>A daily paper.</i>
double	A double measure of spirits. <i>Two whiskies and make it doubles please.</i>
doubled	Twice as great or many. <i>The dose is doubled.</i>
doubly	Two times or in two ways. <i>He was doubly wrong.</i>
dual	In an aircraft using dual controls. <i>A double or dual role for an actor.</i>
multiple	A number that may be divided by another a certain number of times without a remainder. <i>Multiple birth.</i>
oft	Many times at short intervals. <i>An oft quoted tenet.</i>
overexertion	Excessive exertion; so much exertion that discomfort or injury results.
perennial	A perennial plant. <i>Spring streams rise from perennial springs.</i>

<u>periodic</u>	Relating to the periodic table of the elements. <i>The periodic appearance of the seventeen year locust.</i>
<u>recurrent</u>	Occurring often or repeatedly. <i>The recurrent nerve leaves the hypocerebral ganglion.</i>
redouble	A call that doubles a bid already doubled by an opponent. <i>The screaming redoubled.</i>
regular	One of the regular clergy. <i>A regular verb.</i>
reiterate	Say something again or a number of times, typically for emphasis or clarity. <i>She reiterated that the government would remain steadfast in its support.</i>
<u>repeat</u>	Repeat an earlier theme of a composition. <i>He repeated the words after me.</i>
repeated	Done or occurring again several times in the same way. <i>There were repeated attempts to negotiate.</i>
repeating	(of a pattern) recurring uniformly over a surface.
repetition	The action of repeating something that has already been said or written. <i>The tune is full of melodic repetition and sequence.</i>
<u>reprise</u>	Repeat an earlier theme of a composition. <i>He reprises his role as the vigilante architect.</i>
<u>restate</u>	State (something) again or differently, especially more clearly or convincingly. <i>He restated his opposition to abortion.</i>
review	Hold a review of troops. <i>The Director General s end of year review.</i>
tautology	(logic) a statement that is necessarily true. <i>To say that something is <i>adequate enough</i> is a tautology.</i>
<u>times</u>	A more or less definite period of time now or previously present. <i>It was a sign of the times.</i>
twice	To double the degree. <i>The earl married twice.</i>
twofold	Twice as great or as numerous. <i>The twofold demands of the business and motherhood.</i>
<u>weekly</u>	Relating to or calculated in terms of a week. <i>The difference in weekly income is 29 10.</i>
