combined	Made or joined or united into one.
double	Do double duty serve two purposes or have two functions. <i>A double room.</i>
four	A playing card or domino or die whose upward face shows four pips.
incomparable	Unable to be compared; totally different. <i>The incomparable beauty of Venice.</i>
leash	Put a leash on a dog. <i>His violence was barely leashed.</i>
matchless	Eminent beyond or above comparison. <i>The Parthenon has a matchless beauty.</i>
multiple	The product of a quantity by an integer. <i>36 is a multiple of 9.</i>
numeral	Of or denoting a number. <i>A numeral adjective.</i>
once	At a previous time. <i>He never once complained.</i>
oneness	The fact or state of being one in number. <i>A strong sense of oneness is felt with all things.</i>
only	Being the only one single and isolated from others. <i>He was an only child.</i>
peerless	Unequaled; unrivalled. <i>A peerless scholar.</i>
quadruple	A quadruple number or amount. <i>Oil prices quadrupled in the 1970s.</i>
quartet	A composition for a quartet. <i>A Beethoven quartet.</i>
sextuple	Six times as much or as many.

six	Denoting a quantity consisting of six items or units.
ten	One of four playing cards in a deck with ten pips on the face.
ternary	Using three as a base. <i>A ternary operation.</i>
three	One of four playing cards in a deck having three pips.
times	Multiply (a number). <i>You times the six by four to get twenty four.</i>
triad	A chord of three musical notes, consisting of a given note with the third and fifth above it. <i>The triad of medication diet and exercise are necessary in diabetes care.</i>
tricycle	Ride on a tricycle. <i>A small boy tricycled to the end of his driveway.</i>
trinity	The union of the Father and Son and Holy Ghost in one Godhead. <i>The wine was the first of a trinity of three excellent vintages.</i>
trio	A set or group of three people or things. <i>A jazz trio.</i>
triple	Hit a triple. <i>A triple dark rum.</i>
unequaled	Radically distinctive and without equal. <i>Craftsmen whose skill is unequaled.</i>
unified	Made uniform or whole; united. <i>A unified system of national education.</i>
united	Of or relating to two people who are married to each other. <i>Women acting together in a united way.</i>
unpaired	Not forming one of a pair. <i>Unpaired socks.</i>
unrivaled	Eminent beyond or above comparison. <i>Unrivaled mastery of her art.</i>
