aligned	In a straight line. <i>Pearly teeth evenly aligned.</i>
consciousness	An alert cognitive state in which you are aware of yourself and your situation. <i>He lost consciousness.</i>
consecutive	In a consecutive manner. <i>Five consecutive months of serious decline.</i>
deviance	A state or condition markedly different from the norm. <i>Social deviance.</i>
disposed	Naturally disposed toward. <i>He is favourably disposed towards the proposals.</i>
double	To double the degree. <i>Thy fifty yet doth double five and twenty.</i>
ego	Your consciousness of your own identity. <i>He needed a boost to his ego.</i>
exception	A deliberate act of omission. <i>The administrator made an exception in the Colonel s case and waived the normal visiting hours.</i>
group	Put in a group or groups. <i>I now belong to my local drama group.</i>
individual	A single organism. <i>The individual needs of the children.</i>
individuate	Give individual shape or form to. <i>It is easy to individuate and enumerate the significant elements.</i>
number	Place a limit on the number of. <i>The form of English pronouns reflects their number and gender.</i>

numeral	A word expressing a number. <i>A numeral adjective.</i>
oriented	Adjusted or located in relation to surroundings or circumstances; sometimes used in combination. <i>Helping freshmen become oriented to college life.</i>
paranormal	Denoting events or phenomena such as telekinesis or clairvoyance that are beyond the scope of normal scientific understanding. <i>An investigator of the paranormal.</i>
premier	(in Australia and Canada) the chief minister of a government of a state or province. <i>He holds the premier barony in the UK created in 1269.</i>
privacy	A state in which one is not observed or disturbed by other people. <i>A law to restrict newspapers freedom to invade people s privacy.</i>
psychology	The science of mental life. <i>The psychology of interpersonal relationships.</i>
sense	Perceive by a sense or senses. <i>An optical fibre senses a current flowing in a conductor.</i>
sociology	The study of the development, structure, and functioning of human society.
solidarity	A union of interests or purposes or sympathies among members of a group. <i>Factory workers voiced solidarity with the striking students.</i>
subconscious	The subconscious part of the mind not in technical use in psychoanalysis where unconscious is preferred. <i>My subconscious fear.</i>
superego	(psychoanalysis) that part of the unconscious mind that acts as a conscience. <i>True schizophrenias lack the superego elements present in paranoia.</i>
ten	One of four playing cards in a deck with ten pips on the face.
think	An instance of deliberate thinking. <i>What do you think you re doing.</i>
three	One of four playing cards in a deck having three pips.
unnatural	Not normal; not typical or usual or regular or conforming to a norm. <i>The formal tone of the programmes caused them to sound stilted and unnatural.</i>
unorthodox	Breaking with convention or tradition. <i>He frequently upset other scholars with his unorthodox views.</i>
walkway	A path set aside for walking.
