| Infinitive         | <b>to onlap</b>       |
| Present Tense      | <b>onlap / onlaps</b> |
| Past Tense         | <b>onlapped</b>       |
| Present Participle | <b>onlapping</b>      |
| Past Participle    | <b>onlapped</b>       |

## Conjugate Onlap

**Onlap in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular          Plural**

I **onlap**                  We **onlap**  
You **onlap**              You **onlap**  
He/She/It **onlaps**    They **onlap**

### **Onlap in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **am onlapping**          We **are onlapping**  
You **are onlapping**      You **are onlapping**  
He/She/It **is onlapping**    They **are onlapping**

### **Onlap in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have onlapped**          We **have onlapped**  
You **have onlapped**      You **have onlapped**  
He/She/It **has onlapped**    They **have onlapped**

### **Onlap in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have been onlapping**      We **have been onlapping**  
You **have been onlapping**    You **have been onlapping**  
He/She/It **has been onlapping**    They **have been onlapping**

### **Onlap in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **onlapped**                  We **onlapped**  
You **onlapped**              You **onlapped**  
He/She/It **onlapped**      They **onlapped**

### **Onlap in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was onlapping**                      We **were onlapping**  
You **were onlapping**                You **were onlapping**  
He/She/It **was onlapping**        They **were onlapping**

**Onlap in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had onlapped**                      We **had onlapped**  
You **had onlapped**                You **had onlapped**  
He/She/It **had onlapped**        They **had onlapped**

**Onlap in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been onlapping**                We **had been onlapping**  
You **had been onlapping**            You **had been onlapping**  
He/She/It **had been onlapping**    They **had been onlapping**

**Onlap in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will onlap**                      We **will onlap**  
You **will onlap**                You **will onlap**  
He/She/It **will onlap**        They **will onlap**

**Onlap in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be onlapping**                We **will be onlapping**  
You **will be onlapping**            You **will be onlapping**  
He/She/It **will be onlapping**    They **will be onlapping**

**Onlap in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have onlapped**

**We will have onlapped**

**You will have onlapped**

**You will have onlapped**

**He/She/It will have onlapped** **They will have onlapped**

**Onlap in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been onlapping**

**We will have been onlapping**

**You will have been onlapping**

**You will have been onlapping**

**He/She/It will have been onlapping** **They will have been onlapping**
