| <b>ascend</b>                   | (of a voice or sound) rise in pitch.<br><i>The path <b>ascended</b> to the top of the hill.</i>   |
| <b>ascending</b>                | Sloping or leading upwards.<br><i>The <b>ascending</b> stems of chickweed.</i>  |
| <b>ascent</b>                   | An instance of rising or moving up through the air.<br><i>The first <b>ascent</b> of the Matterhorn.</i>  |
| <b>bald</b>                     | Grow bald lose hair on one s head.<br><i>Hedgehogs are born <b>bald</b>.</i>  |
| <a href="#"><u>bare</u></a>     | Just barely adequate or within a lower limit.<br><i>He outlined the <b>bare</b> essentials of the story.</i>  |
| <b>boost</b>                    | Give a boost to be beneficial to.<br><i>The tax cut will <b>boost</b> the economy.</i>  |
| <a href="#"><u>climb</u></a>    | A mountain hill or slope that is climbed.<br><i>We decided to <b>climb</b> to 6 000 feet.</i>   |
| <a href="#"><u>climbing</u></a> | The sport or activity of climbing mountains or cliffs.<br><i><b>Climbing</b> equipment.</i>   |
| <a href="#"><u>elevate</u></a>  | Raise to a more important or impressive level.<br><i>The exercise will naturally <b>elevate</b> your chest and head.</i>  |
| <b>elevator</b>                 | A platform or compartment housed in a shaft for raising and lowering people or things to different levels; a lift.<br><i>In the harbour a giant <b>elevator</b> stores prairie grain.</i> |
| <b>escalator</b>                | A moving staircase consisting of an endlessly circulating belt of steps driven by a motor, which conveys people between the floors of a public building.                                  |
| <b>exposed</b>                  | With no protection or shield.<br><i>The trail is level but very <b>exposed</b> best on a mild day.</i>  |
| <b>grow</b>                     | Allow or cause a part of the body to grow or develop.<br><i>Her hair doesn t <b>grow</b> much anymore.</i>  |

| <b>lift</b>               | Lifting device consisting of a platform or cage that is raised and lowered mechanically in a vertical shaft in order to move people from one floor to another in a building.<br><i>The <b>lift</b> door opened.</i> |
| <b><u>precipitate</u></b> | A substance precipitated from a solution.<br><i>The crisis <b>precipitated</b> by Russia's revolution.</i>  |
| <b>raise</b>              | Raise in rank or condition.<br><i><b>Raise</b> the roof.</i>  |
| <b>rise</b>               | Rise in rank or status.<br><i>I try to <b>rise</b> above prejudice.</i>   |
| <b>risen</b>              | Above the horizon.<br><i>The <b>risen</b> sun.</i>  |
| <b>rising</b>             | Advancing to maturity or high standing.<br><i>A <b>rising</b> trend.</i>  |
| <b><u>soar</u></b>        | Rise rapidly.<br><i>The stock market <b>soared</b> after the cease fire was announced.</i>  |
| <b>stairs</b>             | A flight of stairs or a flight of steps.  |
| <b>stepladder</b>         | A folding portable ladder hinged at the top.  |
| <b>toupee</b>             | A small artificial hairpiece worn to cover a bald spot.   |
| <b>unaided</b>            | Carried out without aid or assistance.<br><i>She can no longer walk <b>unaided</b>.</i>   |
| <b>uphill</b>             | The upward slope of a hill.<br><i>He gave mountain biking clinics on handling steep <b>uphills</b>.</i>   |
| <b>upstairs</b>           | The part of a building above the ground floor.<br><i>I tiptoed <b>upstairs</b>.</i>   |
| <b>upward</b>             | Directed up.<br><i>The fragments flew <b>upwards</b>.</i>   |
| <b>vertically</b>         | At right angles to a horizontal plane; aligned in such a way that the top is directly above the bottom.<br><i>The wheel hangs <b>vertically</b> from a wire.</i>  |
| <b><u>zoom</u></b>        | Cause a lens or camera to zoom in or out.<br><i>The value of these stocks is <b>zooming</b>.</i>  |
