## The Forms of Opinionate

Infinitive	<b>to opinionate</b>
Present Tense	<b>opinionate / opinionates</b>
Past Tense	<b>opinionated</b>
Present Participle	<b>opinionating</b>
Past Participle	<b>opinionated</b>

## Conjugate Opinionate

**Opinionate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

I <b>opinionate</b>	We <b>opinionate</b>
You <b>opinionate</b>	You <b>opinionate</b>
He/She/It <b>opinionates</b>	They <b>opinionate</b>

**Opinionate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>am opinionating</b>	We <b>are opinionating</b>
You <b>are opinionating</b>	You <b>are opinionating</b>
He/She/It <b>is opinionating</b>	They <b>are opinionating</b>

**Opinionate in Present Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>have opinionated</b>	We <b>have opinionated</b>
You <b>have opinionated</b>	You <b>have opinionated</b>
He/She/It <b>has opinionated</b>	They <b>have opinionated</b>

**Opinionate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>have been opinionating</b>	We <b>have been opinionating</b>
You <b>have been opinionating</b>	You <b>have been opinionating</b>
He/She/It <b>has been opinionating</b>	They <b>have been opinionating</b>

**Opinionate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>opinionated</b>	We <b>opinionated</b>
You <b>opinionated</b>	You <b>opinionated</b>
He/She/It <b>opinionated</b>	They <b>opinionated</b>

**Opinionate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I was opinionating</b>	<b>We were opinionating</b>
<b>You were opinionating</b>	<b>You were opinionating</b>
<b>He/She/It was opinionating</b>	<b>They were opinionating</b>

**Opinionate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had opinionated</b>	<b>We had opinionated</b>
<b>You had opinionated</b>	<b>You had opinionated</b>
<b>He/She/It had opinionated</b>	<b>They had opinionated</b>

**Opinionate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been opinionating</b>	<b>We had been opinionating</b>
<b>You had been opinionating</b>	<b>You had been opinionating</b>
<b>He/She/It had been opinionating</b>	<b>They had been opinionating</b>

**Opinionate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Plural**

<b>I will opinionate</b>	<b>We will opinionate</b>
<b>You will opinionate</b>	<b>You will opinionate</b>
<b>He/She/It will opinionate</b>	<b>They will opinionate</b>

**Opinionate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will be opinionating</b>	<b>We will be opinionating</b>
<b>You will be opinionating</b>	<b>You will be opinionating</b>
<b>He/She/It will be opinionating</b>	<b>They will be opinionating</b>

**Opinionate in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have opinionated**

**We will have opinionated**

**You will have opinionated**

**You will have opinionated**

**He/She/It will have opinionated**

**They will have opinionated**

**Opionate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been opionating**

**We will have been opionating**

**You will have been opionating**

**You will have been opionating**

**He/She/It will have been opionating**

**They will have been opionating**
