Definitions of "Opportunistic" as an adjective

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "opportunistic" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- Taking immediate advantage, often unethically, of any circumstance of possible benefit.
- (of a plant or animal) able to spread quickly in a previously unexploited habitat.
- Exploiting immediate opportunities, especially regardless of planning or principle.
- (of a microorganism or an infection caused by it) affecting patients only or chiefly when the immune system is depressed.

egotistic Characteristic of those having an inflated idea of their own importance.

He's selfish **egotistical** and arrogant.

introverted (of an organ or other body part) turned or pushed inward on itself.

opportunist Opportunistic.

The calculating and **opportunist** politician.

self-absorbed Absorbed in your own interests or thoughts etc.

self-centred Limited to or caring only about yourself and your own needs.



self-loving Characteristic of those having an inflated idea of their own importance.

self-seeking Interested only in yourself. self-serving Interested only in yourself.
