## Associations of "Opposite of predecessor" (30 Words)

<a href="#">adversely</a>	In a way that prevents success or development; harmfully or unfavourably. <i>His self confidence was <b>adversely</b> affected for years to come.</i>
<a href="#">antithesis</a>	A person or thing that is the direct opposite of someone or something else. <i>The <b>antithesis</b> between occult and rational mentalities.</i>
<b>antithetical</b>	Directly opposed or contrasted; mutually incompatible. <i>Practices entirely <b>antithetical</b> to her professed beliefs.</i>
<b>backward</b>	(of a fielding position) behind an imaginary line passing through the stumps at the batsman’s end at right angles to the wicket. <i>It s easy to get the i and the e <b>backward</b> in words like seize and siege.</i>
<b>conflicting</b>	In disagreement- John Morley. <i>There are <b>conflicting</b> accounts of what occurred.</i>
<a href="#">contradictory</a>	A contradictory proposition. <i>Politically he exhibited <b>contradictory</b> behaviour.</i>
<b>contrarily</b>	Contrary to expectations.
<a href="#">contrary</a>	A contrary proposition. <i>An Act applies only to the United Kingdom unless the <b>contrary</b> is expressed.</i>
<a href="#">converse</a>	Carry on a conversation. <i>It will be difficult in these <b>converses</b> not to talk of secular matter.</i>
<a href="#">counterpart</a>	A person or thing that corresponds to or has the same function as another person or thing in a different place or situation. <i>The minister held talks with his French <b>counterpart</b>.</i>
<b>diametrical</b>	Related to or along a diameter. <i><b>Diametrical</b> or opposite points of view.</i>
<b>forerunner</b>	A person who goes before or announces the coming of another. <i>The ice safe was a <b>forerunner</b> of today s refrigerator.</i>

<b>genitive</b>	A word in the genitive case. <i>The <b>genitive</b> endings.</i>
<b>harbinger</b>	A forerunner of something. <i>These works were not yet opera but they were the most important <b>harbinger</b> of opera.</i>
<b>headfirst</b>	With the head foremost. <i>A <b>headfirst</b> plunge down the stairs.</i>
<b><u>herald</u></b>	(formal) a person who announces important news. <i>The band have been <b>heralded</b> as the great hope for the nineties.</i>
<b>inverse</b>	Opposite or contrary in position, direction, order, or effect. <i>A term is in <b>inverse</b> proportion to another term if it increases or decreases as the other decreases or increases.</i>
<b>inversion</b>	A transformation in which each point of a given figure is replaced by another point on the same straight line from a fixed point especially in such a way that the product of the distances of the two points from the centre of inversion is constant. <i>Since the company maintains a franchisee model it is a viable target for <b>inversion</b>.</i>
<b>locative</b>	A word in the locative case.
<b><u>oxymoron</u></b>	A figure of speech in which apparently contradictory terms appear in conjunction (e.g. faith unfaithful kept him falsely true).
<b>polarity</b>	Having an indicated pole (as the distinction between positive and negative electric charges). <i>It exhibits <b>polarity</b> when presented to a magnetic needle.</i>
<b><u>preceding</u></b>	Coming before something in order, position, or time. <i>A growth in sales above those of the <b>preceding</b> year.</i>
<b><u>precursor</u></b>	Something that precedes and indicates the approach of something or someone. <i>A three stringed <b>precursor</b> of the violin.</i>
<b>retrograde</b>	Show retrograde motion. <i>Our history must <b>retrograde</b> for the space of a few pages.</i>
<b>reversal</b>	A judgment by a higher court that the judgment of a lower court was incorrect and should be set aside. <i>A <b>reversal</b> by the House of Lords of the Court of Appeal s decision.</i>
<b>reverse</b>	Reverse the position order relation or condition of. <i>The gall actuates a <b>reverse</b> of photosynthesis.</i>
<b><u>revolutionize</u></b>	Fill with revolutionary ideas. <i>This fabulous new theory will <b>revolutionize</b> the whole of science.</i>

- trailblazer** Someone who helps to open up a new line of research or technology or art.  
*He was a **trailblazer** for many ideas that are now standard fare.*
- turnaround** A space for vehicles to turn round in, especially one at the end of a driveway or dead-end street.  
*A seven day **turnaround**.*
