Present Tense	<b>orate / orates</b>
Past Tense	<b>orated</b>
Present Participle	<b>orating</b>
Past Participle	<b>orated</b>

## Conjugate Orate

### Orate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>orate</b>	We <b>orate</b>
You <b>orate</b>	You <b>orate</b>
He/She/It <b>orates</b>	They <b>orate</b>

## **Orate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am orating</b>	We <b>are orating</b>
You <b>are orating</b>	You <b>are orating</b>
He/She/It <b>is orating</b>	They <b>are orating</b>

## **Orate in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have orated</b>	We <b>have orated</b>
You <b>have orated</b>	You <b>have orated</b>
He/She/It <b>has orated</b>	They <b>have orated</b>

## **Orate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been orating</b>	We <b>have been orating</b>
You <b>have been orating</b>	You <b>have been orating</b>
He/She/It <b>has been orating</b>	They <b>have been orating</b>

## **Orate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>orated</b>	We <b>orated</b>
You <b>orated</b>	You <b>orated</b>
He/She/It <b>orated</b>	They <b>orated</b>

## **Orate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

<b>I was orating</b>	<b>We were orating</b>
<b>You were orating</b>	<b>You were orating</b>
<b>He/She/It was orating</b>	<b>They were orating</b>

**Orate in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had orated</b>	<b>We had orated</b>
<b>You had orated</b>	<b>You had orated</b>
<b>He/She/It had orated</b>	<b>They had orated</b>

**Orate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had been orating</b>	<b>We had been orating</b>
<b>You had been orating</b>	<b>You had been orating</b>
<b>He/She/It had been orating</b>	<b>They had been orating</b>

**Orate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will orate</b>	<b>We will orate</b>
<b>You will orate</b>	<b>You will orate</b>
<b>He/She/It will orate</b>	<b>They will orate</b>

**Orate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will be orating</b>	<b>We will be orating</b>
<b>You will be orating</b>	<b>You will be orating</b>
<b>He/She/It will be orating</b>	<b>They will be orating</b>

**I will have orated**

**We will have orated**

**You will have orated**

**You will have orated**

**He/She/It will have orated**

**They will have orated**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been orating**

**We will have been orating**

**You will have been orating**

**You will have been orating**

**He/She/It will have been orating**

**They will have been orating**
