Ordinate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I ordinate We ordinate
You ordinate You ordinate
He/She/It ordinates They ordinate

Ordinate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am ordinating We are ordinating
You are ordinating You are ordinating
He/She/It is ordinating They are ordinating

Ordinate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have ordinated We have ordinated You have ordinated You have ordinated He/She/It has ordinated They have ordinated

Ordinate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been ordinating
You have been ordinating
He/She/It has been ordinating
They have been ordinating

Ordinate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was ordinating We were ordinating
You were ordinating
He/She/It was ordinating They were ordinating

Ordinate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had ordinated We had ordinated You had ordinated He/She/It had ordinated They had ordinated

Ordinate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been ordinating We had been ordinating
You had been ordinating You had been ordinating
He/She/It had been ordinating They had been ordinating

Ordinate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will ordinate
You will ordinate
He/She/It will ordinate
They will ordinate

Ordinate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be ordinating
You will be ordinating
He/She/It will be ordinating
They will be ordinating

Ordinate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have ordinated We will have ordinated You will have ordinated He/She/It will have ordinated They will have ordinated

Ordinate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

I will have been ordinating
You will have been ordinating
He/She/It will have been ordinating
They will have been ordinating
