Past Tense	<b>organised</b>
Present Participle	<b>organising</b>
Past Participle	<b>organised</b>

I **organise**                      We **organise**  
You **organise**                  You **organise**  
He/She/It **organises**      They **organise**

**Organise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am organising**              We **are organising**  
You **are organising**          You **are organising**  
He/She/It **is organising**      They **are organising**

**Organise in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have organised**              We **have organised**  
You **have organised**          You **have organised**  
He/She/It **has organised**      They **have organised**

**Organise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been organising**          We **have been organising**  
You **have been organising**      You **have been organising**  
He/She/It **has been organising**      They **have been organising**

I **organised**                      We **organised**  
You **organised**                  You **organised**  
He/She/It **organised**          They **organised**

**Organise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I **was organising**                      We **were organising**  
You **were organising**                You **were organising**  
He/She/It **was organising**        They **were organising**

He/She/It **had organised**        They **had organised**

I **had been organising**                We **had been organising**  
You **had been organising**            You **had been organising**  
He/She/It **had been organising**    They **had been organising**

I **will organise**                      We **will organise**  
You **will organise**                You **will organise**  
He/She/It **will organise**        They **will organise**

I **will be organising**                We **will be organising**  
You **will be organising**            You **will be organising**  
He/She/It **will be organising**    They **will be organising**

**Organise in Future Perfect Tense**

**I will have organised**

**We will have organised**

**You will have organised**

**You will have organised**

**He/She/It will have organised**

**They will have organised**

**I will have been organising**

**We will have been organising**

**You will have been organising**

**You will have been organising**

**He/She/It will have been organising**

**They will have been organising**
