Associations of "Out of commission" (30 Words)

absentee	One that is absent or not in residence. <i>An absentee from the match.</i>
absenteeism	Habitual absence from work. <i>High levels of absenteeism caused by low job motivation.</i>
away	Out of the way especially away from one's thoughts. <i>He put away the pistol.</i>
camp	A group of people living together in a camp. <i>Camp Hollywood musicals of the 1940s.</i>
committee	In the UK a committee appointed by Parliament to consider the details of proposed legislation. <i>A committee is a group that keeps minutes and loses hours.</i>
competition	The activity or condition of striving to gain or win something by defeating or establishing superiority over others. <i>There is fierce competition between banks.</i>
cottage	A small house with a single story. <i>They said that at some point in their lives they've cottaged or cruised in parks.</i>
delegation	A body of delegates or representatives; a deputation. <i>A delegation of teachers.</i>
deputation	A group of representatives or delegates. <i>He had been a member of a deputation to Napoleon III.</i>
doorway	An entrance to a room or building through a door. <i>The doorway to success.</i>
exclude	Prevent from entering; shut out. <i>Clauses seeking to exclude liability for loss or damage.</i>
exhale	Give off (vapour or fumes). <i>The jungle exhaled mists of early morning.</i>

fraternity	A group of people sharing a common profession or interests. <i>Members of the hunting fraternity.</i>
habitable	Fit for habitation. <i>The house should be habitable by Christmas.</i>
habitat	The type of environment in which an organism or group normally lives or occurs. <i>A marine habitat.</i>
hall	United States astronomer who discovered Phobos and Deimos (the two satellites of Mars) (1829-1907). <i>The village hall.</i>
home	Made done or intended for use in the home. <i>He doesn't have a home to go to.</i>
house	The management of a gambling house or casino. <i>Make yourself scarce before you wake the whole house.</i>
household	The establishment and affairs of a royal household. <i>It was a good Christian household.</i>
indoor	Relating to sports played indoors. <i>Indoor sports.</i>
judiciary	The system of law courts that administer justice and constitute the judicial branch of government. <i>The independence of the judiciary.</i>
lodging	The act of lodging. <i>He was looking for lodgings and a job.</i>
meeting	A situation when two or more people meet, by chance or arrangement. <i>There was no meeting of minds.</i>
member	An organization that is a member of another organization especially a state that belongs to a group of nations. <i>Canada is a member of the United Nations.</i>
mews	A group of stables, typically with rooms above, built round a yard or along an alley. <i>An eighteenth century mews.</i>
mission	A group of people sent on a mission. <i>The planes were on a bombing mission.</i>
parliamentary	Relating to, enacted by, or suitable for a parliament. <i>A parliamentary candidate.</i>
senate	The governing body of a university or college. <i>The senate must ratify any treaty with a two thirds majority.</i>

supervisory Of or limited to or involving supervision.
*The women play a largely **supervisory** role in the process.*

tent Live or stay for a while in a tent.
*We **tented** with the kids on the shores of Lake Huron.*
