## Associations of "Out of commission" (30 Words)

<b>absentee</b>	One that is absent or not in residence. <i>An <b>absentee</b> from the match.</i>
<b><a href="#">absenteeism</a></b>	Habitual absence from work. <i>High levels of <b>absenteeism</b> caused by low job motivation.</i>
<b><a href="#">away</a></b>	Out of the way especially away from one's thoughts. <i>He put <b>away</b> the pistol.</i>
<b><a href="#">camp</a></b>	A group of people living together in a camp. <i><b>Camp</b> Hollywood musicals of the 1940s.</i>
<b>committee</b>	In the UK a committee appointed by Parliament to consider the details of proposed legislation. <i>A <b>committee</b> is a group that keeps minutes and loses hours.</i>
<b>competition</b>	The activity or condition of striving to gain or win something by defeating or establishing superiority over others. <i>There is fierce <b>competition</b> between banks.</i>
<b><a href="#">cottage</a></b>	A small house with a single story. <i>They said that at some point in their lives they've <b>cottaged</b> or cruised in parks.</i>
<b>delegation</b>	A body of delegates or representatives; a deputation. <i>A <b>delegation</b> of teachers.</i>
<b>deputation</b>	A group of representatives or delegates. <i>He had been a member of a <b>deputation</b> to Napoleon III.</i>
<b><a href="#">doorway</a></b>	An entrance to a room or building through a door. <i>The <b>doorway</b> to success.</i>
<b>exclude</b>	Prevent from entering; shut out. <i>Clauses seeking to <b>exclude</b> liability for loss or damage.</i>
<b><a href="#">exhale</a></b>	Give off (vapour or fumes). <i>The jungle <b>exhaled</b> mists of early morning.</i>

<b>fraternity</b>	A group of people sharing a common profession or interests. <i>Members of the hunting <b>fraternity</b>.</i>
<b>habitable</b>	Fit for habitation. <i>The house should be <b>habitable</b> by Christmas.</i>
<b>habitat</b>	The type of environment in which an organism or group normally lives or occurs. <i>A marine <b>habitat</b>.</i>
<b>hall</b>	United States astronomer who discovered Phobos and Deimos (the two satellites of Mars) (1829-1907). <i>The village <b>hall</b>.</i>
<b>home</b>	Made done or intended for use in the home. <i>He doesn't have a <b>home</b> to go to.</i>
<b>house</b>	The management of a gambling house or casino. <i>Make yourself scarce before you wake the whole <b>house</b>.</i>
<b>household</b>	The establishment and affairs of a royal household. <i>It was a good Christian <b>household</b>.</i>
<b>indoor</b>	Relating to sports played indoors. <i><b>Indoor</b> sports.</i>
<b>judiciary</b>	The system of law courts that administer justice and constitute the judicial branch of government. <i>The independence of the <b>judiciary</b>.</i>
<b>lodging</b>	The act of lodging. <i>He was looking for <b>lodgings</b> and a job.</i>
<b>meeting</b>	A situation when two or more people meet, by chance or arrangement. <i>There was no <b>meeting</b> of minds.</i>
<b>member</b>	An organization that is a member of another organization especially a state that belongs to a group of nations. <i>Canada is a <b>member</b> of the United Nations.</i>
<b>mews</b>	A group of stables, typically with rooms above, built round a yard or along an alley. <i>An eighteenth century <b>mews</b>.</i>
<b>mission</b>	A group of people sent on a mission. <i>The planes were on a bombing <b>mission</b>.</i>
<b>parliamentary</b>	Relating to, enacted by, or suitable for a parliament. <i>A <b>parliamentary</b> candidate.</i>
<b>senate</b>	The governing body of a university or college. <i>The <b>senate</b> must ratify any treaty with a two thirds majority.</i>

**supervisory** Of or limited to or involving supervision.  
*The women play a largely **supervisory** role in the process.*

**tent** Live or stay for a while in a tent.  
*We **tented** with the kids on the shores of Lake Huron.*
