| absentee | One that is absent or not in residence. <i>An absentee from the match.</i> |
| away | An away match or win. <i>He put away the pistol.</i> |
| bedroom | A room used primarily for sleeping. <i>A hotel with nearly 200 bedrooms.</i> |
| besides | Making an additional point; anyway. <i>I m capable of doing the work and a lot more besides.</i> |
| by | In reserve; not for immediate use. <i>Put something by for her old age.</i> |
| denude | Lay bare. <i>Denude a forest.</i> |
| devoid | Completely wanting or lacking. <i>Lisa kept her voice devoid of emotion.</i> |
| distant | Remote in manner. <i>Distant lands.</i> |
| doorway | The entrance (the space in a wall) through which you enter or leave a room or building; the space that a door can close. <i>He stuck his head in the doorway.</i> |
| everywhere | Common or widely distributed. <i>He carried a gun everywhere he went.</i> |
| except | Take exception to. <i>Five classes of advertisement are excepted from control.</i> |
| exclude | Lack or fail to include. <i>The bad results were excluded from the report.</i> |
| exhale | Give off (vapour or fumes). <i>The chimney exhales a thick smoke.</i> |

| furnished | (of accommodation) available to be rented with furniture. <i>A furnished apartment.</i> |
| habitable | Suitable or good enough to live in. <i>The house should be habitable by Christmas.</i> |
| hall | A large room in a mansion or palace used for receptions and banquets. <i>For a brief time they had shared a room in hall.</i> |
| home | Return home accurately from a long distance. <i>The United States is the home of basketball.</i> |
| household | The establishment and affairs of a royal household. <i>The whole household was asleep.</i> |
| indoor | Relating to sports played indoors. <i>The national indoor champion.</i> |
| indoors | Into or within a building. <i>They went indoors and explored the house.</i> |
| leave | Leave unchanged or undisturbed or refrain from taking. <i>We were almost the last to leave.</i> |
| locate | Determine or indicate the place, site, or limits of, as if by an instrument or by a survey. <i>Can you locate your cousins in the Midwest.</i> |
| none | By no amount; not at all. <i>It is made none the easier by the differences in approach.</i> |
| nothing | Having no prospect of progress; of no value. <i>It looked like nothing I had ever seen before.</i> |
| omit | Prevent from being included or considered or accepted. <i>He was omitted from the second Test.</i> |
| outdoor | Pertaining to or concerning the outdoors or outdoor activities. <i>A huge outdoor concert.</i> |
| porch | A covered shelter projecting in front of the entrance of a building. <i>Daniel and Lydia sat out on the porch for many hours.</i> |
| somewhere | In or at or to some place someplace is used informally for somewhere. <i>She must be somewhere.</i> |
| treetop | The uppermost part of a tree. |
| zip | Fasten with a zip. <i>He zipped up his waterproof.</i> |
