| <b>besides</b>    | Making an additional point; anyway.<br><i>I m capable of doing the work and a lot more <b>besides</b>.</i>  |
| <b>by</b>         | In reserve; not for immediate use.<br><i>Put something <b>by</b> for her old age.</i>   |
| <b>denude</b>     | Lay bare.<br><i><b>Denude</b> a forest.</i>   |
| <b>devoid</b>     | Completely wanting or lacking.<br><i>Lisa kept her voice <b>devoid</b> of emotion.</i>  |
| <b>distant</b>    | Remote in manner.<br><i><b>Distant</b> lands.</i>   |
| <b>doorway</b>    | The entrance (the space in a wall) through which you enter or leave a room or building; the space that a door can close.<br><i>He stuck his head in the <b>doorway</b>.</i> |
| <b>everywhere</b> | Common or widely distributed.<br><i>He carried a gun <b>everywhere</b> he went.</i>   |
| <b>except</b>     | Take exception to.<br><i>Five classes of advertisement are <b>excepted</b> from control.</i>  |
| <b>exclude</b>    | Lack or fail to include.<br><i>The bad results were <b>excluded</b> from the report.</i>  |
| <b>exhale</b>     | Give off (vapour or fumes).<br><i>The chimney <b>exhales</b> a thick smoke.</i>   |

| <b>furnished</b> | (of accommodation) available to be rented with furniture.<br><i>A <b>furnished</b> apartment.</i>  |
| <b>habitable</b> | Suitable or good enough to live in.<br><i>The house should be <b>habitable</b> by Christmas.</i>   |
| <b>hall</b>      | A large room in a mansion or palace used for receptions and banquets.<br><i>For a brief time they had shared a room in <b>hall</b>.</i>                  |
| <b>home</b>      | Return home accurately from a long distance.<br><i>The United States is the <b>home</b> of basketball.</i>   |
| <b>household</b> | The establishment and affairs of a royal household.<br><i>The whole <b>household</b> was asleep.</i>   |
| <b>indoor</b>    | Relating to sports played indoors.<br><i>The national <b>indoor</b> champion.</i>  |
| <b>indoors</b>   | Into or within a building.<br><i>They went <b>indoors</b> and explored the house.</i>  |
| <b>leave</b>     | Leave unchanged or undisturbed or refrain from taking.<br><i>We were almost the last to <b>leave</b>.</i>  |
| <b>locate</b>    | Determine or indicate the place, site, or limits of, as if by an instrument or by a survey.<br><i>Can you <b>locate</b> your cousins in the Midwest.</i> |
| <b>none</b>      | By no amount; not at all.<br><i>It is made <b>none</b> the easier by the differences in approach.</i>  |
| <b>nothing</b>   | Having no prospect of progress; of no value.<br><i>It looked like <b>nothing</b> I had ever seen before.</i>   |
| <b>omit</b>      | Prevent from being included or considered or accepted.<br><i>He was <b>omitted</b> from the second Test.</i>   |
| <b>outdoor</b>   | Pertaining to or concerning the outdoors or outdoor activities.<br><i>A huge <b>outdoor</b> concert.</i>   |
| <b>porch</b>     | A covered shelter projecting in front of the entrance of a building.<br><i>Daniel and Lydia sat out on the <b>porch</b> for many hours.</i>              |
| <b>somewhere</b> | In or at or to some place someplace is used informally for somewhere.<br><i>She must be <b>somewhere</b>.</i>  |
| <b>treetop</b>   | The uppermost part of a tree.  |
| <b>zip</b>       | Fasten with a zip.<br><i>He <b>zipped</b> up his waterproof.</i>   |
