## Associations of "Out of service" (30 Words)

<b>accommodate</b>	Provide with something desired or needed. <i>Any language must <b>accommodate</b> new concepts.</i>
<b>appointment</b>	Law the act of disposing of property by virtue of the power of appointment. <i>He applied for an <b>appointment</b> in the treasury.</i>
<b>babysitting</b>	The care of a child or children while the parents are out. <i>I used to do a lot of free <b>babysitting</b>.</i>
<b>booking</b>	An instance of a player being cautioned by the referee for foul play. <i>Early <b>booking</b> is essential.</i>
<b>buyout</b>	Acquisition of a company by purchasing a controlling percentage of its stock.
<b>cater</b>	Supply food ready to eat; for parties and banquets. <i>My mother helped to <b>cater</b> for the party.</i>
<b>chore</b>	A specific piece of work required to be done as a duty or for a specific fee. <i>He sees interviews as a <b>chore</b>.</i>
<b>cleaning</b>	The action of making something clean, especially the inside of a house. <i>He gave his shoes a good <b>cleaning</b>.</i>
<b>client</b>	A program that is capable of obtaining a service provided by another program. <i>Friendly <b>client</b> programs like this enable you to perform complicated actions in just a mouse press or two.</i>
<b>customer</b>	A person of a specified kind with whom one has to deal. <i>He s a tough <b>customer</b>.</i>
<b>dedicate</b>	Ceremonially assign (a church or other building) to a deity or saint. <i>Volume four is <b>dedicated</b> to wasps.</i>
<b>deliver</b>	Bring to a destination make a delivery. <i>The products should be <b>delivered</b> on time.</i>

<b>depart</b>	Leave, especially in order to start a journey. <i>The train <b>departs</b> at noon.</i>
<b>hostess</b>	A stewardess on an aircraft, train, etc. <i>The perfect dinner party <b>hostess</b>.</i>
<b>housekeeping</b>	The work of cleaning and running a house. <i><b>Housekeeping</b> genes.</i>
<b>lodging</b>	The act of lodging. <i>A fee for board and <b>lodging</b>.</i>
<b>menial</b>	A person with a menial job. <i><b>Menial</b> factory jobs.</i>
<b>offering</b>	The verbal act of offering. <i>Noteworthy new <b>offerings</b> for investors included several index funds.</i>
<b>overhaul</b>	Periodic maintenance on a car or machine. <i>You should <b>overhaul</b> your car engine.</i>
<b>provide</b>	Make a possibility or provide opportunity for permit to be attainable or cause to remain. <i>The Bill <b>provides</b> for the setting of guaranteed service standards.</i>
<b>reservation</b>	An unstated doubt that prevents you from accepting something wholeheartedly. <i>The retention of a right to enter the demised property will be a <b>reservation</b>.</i>
<b>reserve</b>	A district that is reserved for particular purpose. <i>The editor <b>reserves</b> the right to edit letters.</i>
<b>restaurant</b>	A building where people go to eat.
<b>sacrifice</b>	Personnel that are sacrificed e.g. surrendered or lost in order to gain an objective. <i>The general had to <b>sacrifice</b> several soldiers to save the regiment.</i>
<b>scullion</b>	A kitchen servant employed to do menial tasks (especially washing).
<b>stockpile</b>	Accumulate a large stock of (goods or materials). <i>A <b>stockpile</b> of sandbags was being prepared.</i>
<b>stopover</b>	A stopping place on a journey. <i>They made a <b>stopover</b> to visit their friends.</i>
<b>supplement</b>	Serve as a supplement to. <i>The single room <b>supplement</b> is 2 per night.</i>
<b>supplier</b>	Someone whose business is to supply a particular service or commodity. <i>The company has to pay <b>suppliers</b> within 90 days of purchase.</i>
