ashen	Anemic looking from illness or emotion. <i>The ashen colour of the landscape.</i>
azure	Color azure. <i>Thin streaks of cloud trailed across an azure sky.</i>
black	A black thing in particular the black ball in snooker. <i>The smoke blackened the ceiling.</i>
brown	Brown colour or pigment. <i>The brown of his eyes.</i>
brownish	Of a color similar to that of wood or earth. <i>Where I live the soil is brownish red.</i>
color	Decorate with colors. <i>My personal feelings color my judgment in this case.</i>
dark	The time after sunset and before sunrise while it is dark outside. <i>Dark colors like wine red or navy blue.</i>
downcast	Filled with melancholy and despondency. <i>A downcast glance.</i>
dun	An artificial fishing fly made to resemble a dun. <i>The grocer dunned his customers every day by telephone.</i>
ebony	Used in names of trees that produce timber similar to ebony e.g. Jamaican ebony or American ebony. <i>His ebony hair.</i>
fawn	Have fawns. <i>The forest was closed for hunting when the does were fawning.</i>
gray	Horse of a light gray or whitish color. <i>Gray flannel suit.</i>
grey	Showing characteristics of age especially having grey or white hair. <i>Dirty intermediate tones of grey.</i>

hue	A colour or shade. <i>Men of all political hues submerged their feuds.</i>
magenta	A primary subtractive color for light a dark purple red color the dye for magenta was discovered in 1859 the year of the battle of Magenta. <i>A short magenta dress.</i>
marbled	Patterned with veins or streaks or color resembling marble. <i>Attractively marbled cloth or paper.</i>
maroon	Of a brownish-red colour. <i>The travellers were marooned.</i>
orange	A butterfly with mainly or partly orange wings. <i>The most shocking of pinks and oranges.</i>
phosphorescence	A fluorescence that persists after the bombarding radiation has ceased. <i>The stones overhead gleamed with phosphorescence.</i>
pigmentation	Coloration of living tissues by pigment.
pink	The pink ball in snooker. <i>The car pinked when the ignition was too far retarded.</i>
polychrome	Color with many colors make polychrome. <i>Painters gilded and polychromed the wooden carvings.</i>
purple	Make or become purple in colour. <i>Purple tyrant.</i>
red	Denoting a red light or flag used as a signal to stop. <i>His hair was red.</i>
sky	Throw or toss with a light motion. <i>Hundreds of stars were shining in the sky.</i>
somber	Lacking brightness or color; dull. <i>A suit of somber black.</i>
tint	Dye someone s hair with a tint. <i>The sky was taking on an apricot tint.</i>
welkin	The sky or heaven.
white	Restricted to whites only. <i>A bottle of house white.</i>
yellow	Any of a number of plant diseases in which the leaves turn yellow typically caused by viruses and transmitted by insects. <i>He missed an easy yellow in frame four.</i>
