<b>earth</b>	Connect to the earth. <i>God s will be done on <b>earth</b> as it is in heaven.</i>
<b>globalize</b>	Develop or be developed so as to make international influence or operation possible. <i>Markets are being increasingly <b>globalized</b>.</i>
<b>globe</b>	Form something into a globe. <i>A brandy <b>globe</b>.</i>
<b>globular</b>	Having the shape of a sphere or ball. <i>Plants with distinctive <b>globular</b> blooms.</i>

<b><u>immigration</u></b>	Migration into a place (especially migration to a country of which you are not a native in order to settle there. <i>The increased <b>immigration</b> strengthened the colony.</i>
<b><u>import</u></b>	Great significance importance. <i>The <b>import</b> of his announcement was ambiguous.</i>
<b><u>international</u></b>	A player who has taken part in an international game or contest. <i>An <b>international</b> agreement.</i>
<b>lunar</b>	Of or relating to or associated with the moon. <i>A <b>lunar</b> eclipse.</i>
<b>macrocosm</b>	Everything that exists anywhere.
<b>multinational</b>	Involving or operating in several nations or nationalities. <i>1 500 troops were sent to join the <b>multinational</b> force.</i>
<b>occident</b>	The hemisphere that includes North America and South America.
<b>planetary</b>	Of or relating to or resembling the physical or orbital characteristics of a planet or the planets. <i><b>Planetary</b> air pollution and climatic change.</i>
<b>shuttle</b>	Transport in a shuttle. <i>The nine o clock <b>shuttle</b> from Edinburgh.</i>
<b>southbound</b>	Travelling or leading towards the south. <i>The <b>southbound</b> carriageway of the A1.</i>
<b>southward</b>	Toward the south. <i>Cool air from the ocean to the <b>southward</b>.</i>
<b>spacecraft</b>	A vehicle used for travelling in space.
<b>spaceman</b>	An astronaut.
<b>spaceship</b>	A spacecraft designed to carry a crew into interstellar space (especially in science fiction).
<b><u>tour</u></b>	Make a tour of a certain place. <i>They took an extended <b>tour</b> of Europe.</i>
<b><u>traveler</u></b>	A person who changes location.
<b><u>universe</u></b>	All existing matter and space considered as a whole the cosmos The universe is believed to be at least 10 billion light years in diameter and contains a vast number of galaxies it has been expanding since its creation in the Big Bang about 13 billion years ago. <i>The front parlour was the hub of her <b>universe</b>.</i>
