cosmos	Everything that exists anywhere. <i>The new gender free intellectual cosmos.</i>
earth	Connect to the earth. <i>God s will be done on earth as it is in heaven.</i>
globalize	Develop or be developed so as to make international influence or operation possible. <i>Markets are being increasingly globalized.</i>
globe	Form something into a globe. <i>A brandy globe.</i>
globular	Having the shape of a sphere or ball. <i>Plants with distinctive globular blooms.</i>

<u>immigration</u>	Migration into a place (especially migration to a country of which you are not a native in order to settle there. <i>The increased immigration strengthened the colony.</i>
<u>import</u>	Great significance importance. <i>The import of his announcement was ambiguous.</i>
<u>international</u>	A player who has taken part in an international game or contest. <i>An international agreement.</i>
lunar	Of or relating to or associated with the moon. <i>A lunar eclipse.</i>
macrocosm	Everything that exists anywhere.
multinational	Involving or operating in several nations or nationalities. <i>1 500 troops were sent to join the multinational force.</i>
occident	The hemisphere that includes North America and South America.
planetary	Of or relating to or resembling the physical or orbital characteristics of a planet or the planets. <i>Planetary air pollution and climatic change.</i>
shuttle	Transport in a shuttle. <i>The nine o clock shuttle from Edinburgh.</i>
southbound	Travelling or leading towards the south. <i>The southbound carriageway of the A1.</i>
southward	Toward the south. <i>Cool air from the ocean to the southward.</i>
spacecraft	A vehicle used for travelling in space.
spaceman	An astronaut.
spaceship	A spacecraft designed to carry a crew into interstellar space (especially in science fiction).
<u>tour</u>	Make a tour of a certain place. <i>They took an extended tour of Europe.</i>
<u>traveler</u>	A person who changes location.
<u>universe</u>	All existing matter and space considered as a whole the cosmos The universe is believed to be at least 10 billion light years in diameter and contains a vast number of galaxies it has been expanding since its creation in the Big Bang about 13 billion years ago. <i>The front parlour was the hub of her universe.</i>
<u>worldwide</u>	Of worldwide scope or applicability. <i>Of worldwide significance.</i>
