Infinitive	to overassess
Present Tense	overassess / overassesses
Past Tense	overassessed
Present Participle	overassessing
Past Participle	overassessed

# **Conjugate Overassess**

### **Overassess in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I overassess	We <b>overassess</b>
You <b>overassess</b>	You <b>overassess</b>
He/She/It overassesses	They <b>overassess</b>

### **Overassess in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am overassessing	We are overassessing
You <b>are overassessing</b>	You are overassessing
He/She/It is overassessing	They are overassessing

#### **Overassess in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have overassessed	We have overassessed
You have overassessed	You have overassessed
He/She/It has overassessed	They have overassessed

### **Overassess in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been overassessing	We have been overassessing
You <b>have been overassessing</b>	You have been overassessing
He/She/It has been overassessing	They have been overassessing

### **Overassess in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I overassessed	We <b>overassessed</b>
You <b>overassessed</b>	You <b>overassessed</b>
He/She/It overassessed	They <b>overassessed</b>

#### **Overassess in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was overassessing	We were overassessing
You <b>were overassessing</b>	You were overassessing
He/She/It was overassessing	They were overassessing

#### **Overassess in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had overassessed	We had overassessed
You <b>had overassessed</b>	You had overassessed
He/She/It had overassessed	They had overassessed

### **Overassess in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been overassessing	We had been overassessing
You <b>had been overassessing</b>	You had been overassessing
He/She/It had been overassessing	They had been overassessing

### **Overassess in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will overassess	We <b>will overassess</b>
You <b>will overassess</b>	You <b>will overassess</b>
He/She/It will overassess	They will overassess

### **Overassess in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be overassessing	We will be overassessing
You <b>will be overassessing</b>	You will be overassessing
He/She/It will be overassessing	They will be overassessing

### **Overassess in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have overassessed	We <b>will have overassessed</b>
You <b>will have overassessed</b>	You <b>will have overassessed</b>
He/She/It will have overassessed	They will have overassessed

## **Overassess in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been overassessing	We will have been overassessing
You <b>will have been overassessing</b>	You will have been overassessing
He/She/It will have been overassessing	They will have been overassessing
