blustering	Talking in a loud, aggressive, or indignant way with little effect. <i>Blustering or blustering winds of Patagonia.</i>
brash	Self-assertive in a rude, noisy, or overbearing way. <i>He was brash cocky and arrogant.</i>
cocksure	Marked by excessive confidence. <i>The cocksure golf prodigy from California.</i>
conceited	Excessively proud of oneself; vain. <i>An attitude of self conceited arrogance.</i>
foolhardy	Marked by defiant disregard for danger or consequences-Macaulay. <i>It would be foolhardy to go into the scheme without support.</i>

<u>overbearing</u>	Unpleasantly overpowering. <i>An overbearing ill tempered brute.</i>
overweening	Showing excessive confidence or pride. <i>Overweening greed.</i>
positive	Having a positive charge. <i>The company received a positive response from investors.</i>
presuming	Presumptuous.
<u>presumptuous</u>	Excessively forward. <i>The duchess would not put up with presumptuous servants.</i>
self-assertive	Offensively self assertive.
self-assured	Showing poise and confidence in your own worth.
<u>smug</u>	Having or showing an excessive pride in oneself or one's achievements. <i>He was feeling smug after his win.</i>
swaggering	Having a very confident and arrogant or self-important manner. <i>A swaggering gait.</i>
<u>unabashed</u>	Not embarrassed- Jerome Stone. <i>A tinsel charm and unabashed sentimentality.</i>
