blustering	Talking in a loud, aggressive, or indignant way with little effect. Blustering or blusterous winds of Patagonia.
brash	Self-assertive in a rude, noisy, or overbearing way. <i>He was brash cocky and arrogant.</i>
cocksure	Marked by excessive confidence. The cocksure golf prodigy from California.
conceited	Excessively proud of oneself; vain. An attitude of self conceited arrogance.
foolhardy	Marked by defiant disregard for danger or consequences-Macaulay. It would be foolhardy to go into the scheme without support.



<u>overbearing</u>	Unpleasantly overpowering. An overbearing ill tempered brute.
overweening	Showing excessive confidence or pride. <i>Overweening</i> greed.
positive	Having a positive charge. <i>The company received a positive response from investors.</i>
presuming	Presumptuous.
<u>presumptuous</u>	Excessively forward. The duchess would not put up with presumptuous servants.
self-assertive	Offensively self assertive.
self-assured	Showing poise and confidence in your own worth.
<u>smug</u>	Having or showing an excessive pride in oneself or one's achievements. <i>He was feeling smug after his win.</i>
swaggering	Having a very confident and arrogant or self-important manner. A swaggering gait.
<u>unabashed</u>	Not embarrassed- Jerome Stone. A tinseled charm and unabashed sentimentality.
