I **overmedicalize** We **overmedicalize**
You **overmedicalize** You **overmedicalize**
He/She/It **overmedicalizes** They **overmedicalize**

Overmedicalize in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I **am overmedicalizing** We **are overmedicalizing**
You **are overmedicalizing** You **are overmedicalizing**
He/She/It **is overmedicalizing** They **are overmedicalizing**

I will have overmedicalized

You will have overmedicalized

He/She/It will have overmedicalized

Plural

We will have overmedicalized

You will have overmedicalized

They will have overmedicalized

I will have been overmedicalizing

You will have been overmedicalizing

He/She/It will have been overmedicalizing

Plural

We will have been overmedicalizing

You will have been overmedicalizing
