# **Conjugate Oversay**

#### **Oversay in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I oversay	We <b>oversay</b>
You <b>oversay</b>	You <b>oversay</b>
He/She/It oversays	They <b>oversay</b>

#### **Oversay in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am oversaying	We <b>are oversaying</b>
You <b>are oversaying</b>	You <b>are oversaying</b>
He/She/It is oversaying	They are oversaying

#### **Oversay in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have oversaid	We have oversaid
You <b>have oversaid</b>	You have oversaid
He/She/It has oversaid	They have oversaid

#### **Oversay in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been oversaying	We have been oversaying
You <b>have been oversaying</b>	You have been oversaying
He/She/It has been oversaying	They have been oversaying

#### **Oversay in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>oversaid</b>	We <b>oversaid</b>
You <b>oversaid</b>	You <b>oversaid</b>
He/She/It oversaid	They <b>oversaid</b>

#### **Oversay in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was oversaying	We were oversaying
You were oversaying	You were oversaying
He/She/It was oversaying	They were oversaying

#### **Oversay in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had oversaid	We had oversaid
You <b>had oversaid</b>	You had oversaid
He/She/It had oversaid	They had oversaid

#### **Oversay in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been oversaying	We had been oversaying
You <b>had been oversaying</b>	You had been oversaying
He/She/It had been oversaying	They had been oversaying

#### **Oversay in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will oversay	We <b>will oversay</b>
You <b>will oversay</b>	You <b>will oversay</b>
He/She/It will oversay	They will oversay

### **Oversay in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be oversaying	We will be oversaying
You <b>will be oversaying</b>	You will be oversaying
He/She/It will be oversaying	They will be oversaying

#### **Oversay in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have oversaid	We will have oversaid
You <b>will have oversaid</b>	You <b>will have oversaid</b>
He/She/It will have oversaid	They will have oversaid

## **Oversay in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been oversaying	We <b>will have been oversaying</b>
You <b>will have been oversaying</b>	You <b>will have been oversaying</b>
He/She/It will have been oversaying	They will have been oversaying
