Present Tense	<b>overschedule / overschedules</b>
Past Tense	<b>overscheduled</b>
Present Participle	<b>overscheduling</b>
Past Participle	<b>overscheduled</b>

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **overschedule**                      We **overschedule**  
You **overschedule**                  You **overschedule**  
He/She/It **overschedules**      They **overschedule**

**Overschedule in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am overscheduling**              We **are overscheduling**  
You **are overscheduling**        You **are overscheduling**  
He/She/It **is overscheduling**    They **are overscheduling**

**Overschedule in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have overscheduled**              We **have overscheduled**  
You **have overscheduled**        You **have overscheduled**  
He/She/It **has overscheduled**    They **have overscheduled**

I **have been overscheduling**        We **have been overscheduling**  
You **have been overscheduling**    You **have been overscheduling**  
He/She/It **has been overscheduling**    They **have been overscheduling**

I **was overscheduling**      We **were overscheduling**  
You **were overscheduling**      You **were overscheduling**  
He/She/It **was overscheduling**      They **were overscheduling**

**Overschedule in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**I will have overscheduled**

**You will have overscheduled**

**He/She/It will have overscheduled**

**Plural**

**We will have overscheduled**

**You will have overscheduled**

**They will have overscheduled**

**I will have been overscheduling**

**You will have been overscheduling**

**He/She/It will have been overscheduling**

**Plural**

**We will have been overscheduling**

**You will have been overscheduling**
