# **The Forms of Overspecialise**

Infinitive	to overspecialise
Present Tense	overspecialise / overspecialises
Past Tense	overspecialised
Present Participle	overspecialising
Past Participle	overspecialised

# **Conjugate Overspecialise**

## **Overspecialise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I overspecialise	We overspecialise
You <b>overspecialise</b>	You <b>overspecialise</b>
He/She/It overspecialises	They <b>overspecialise</b>

## **Overspecialise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am overspecialising	We are overspecialising
You <b>are overspecialising</b>	You are overspecialising
He/She/It is overspecialising	They are overspecialising

#### **Overspecialise in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have overspecialised	We have overspecialised
You <b>have overspecialised</b>	You have overspecialised
He/She/It has overspecialised	They have overspecialised

## **Overspecialise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been overspecialising	We have been overspecialising
You have been overspecialising	You have been overspecialising
He/She/It has been overspecialising	They have been overspecialising

## **Overspecialise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I overspecialised	We <b>overspecialised</b>
You <b>overspecialised</b>	You <b>overspecialised</b>
He/She/It overspecialised	They <b>overspecialised</b>

#### **Overspecialise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



SingularPluralI was overspecialisingWe were overspecialisingYou were overspecialisingYou were overspecialisingHe/She/It was overspecialisingThey were overspecialising

#### **Overspecialise in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had overspecialised	We had overspecialised
You <b>had overspecialised</b>	You had overspecialised
He/She/It had overspecialised	They had overspecialised

## **Overspecialise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been overspecialising	We had been overspecialising
You <b>had been overspecialising</b>	You <b>had been overspecialising</b>
He/She/It had been overspecialising	They had been overspecialising

## **Overspecialise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will overspecialise	We will overspecialise
You <b>will overspecialise</b>	You <b>will overspecialise</b>
He/She/It will overspecialise	They will overspecialise

### **Overspecialise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be overspecialising	We <b>will be overspecialising</b>
You <b>will be overspecialising</b>	You will be overspecialising
He/She/It will be overspecialising	They will be overspecialising

#### **Overspecialise in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have overspecialised	We will have overspecialised
You will have overspecialised	You <b>will have overspecialised</b>
He/She/It will have overspecialised	They will have overspecialised

# **Overspecialise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been overspecialising	We will have been overspecialising
You <b>will have been overspecialising</b>	You <b>will have been overspecialising</b>
He/She/It will have been overspecialising	J They will have been overspecialising
