overpoweringly
In a way that is too attractive and tempting to be resisted. Men are irresistibly attracted to her.
Incapable of being resisted. He found the weather overpoweringly hot.

Usage Examples of "Overwhelmingly" as an adverb

- *The country voted overwhelmingly for independence.*
- The reaction has been overwhelmingly positive.
- The candy looked overwhelmingly desirable to the dieting man.



Associations of "Overwhelmingly" (30 Words)

accepted	Generally approved or compelling recognition. Several accepted techniques for treating the condition.
always	At all times; on all occasions. I will always be there to help you.
basically	In essence; at bottom or by one's (or its) very nature. I basically played the same thing every night.
<u>broadly</u>	In general and without considering minor details. Broadly speaking the risks are as follows.
<u>chiefly</u>	For the most part; mostly. An audience consisting chiefly of women between the ages of 18 and 54.
commonly	Very often; frequently. A commonly used industrial chemical.
<u>consist</u>	Be consistent with. Much propaganda simply consist s in presenting the officially approved version of the truth as reality.
<u>essentially</u>	In essence; at bottom or by one's (or its) very nature. The argument was essentially a technical one.
exceptionally	Only in unusual circumstances. The court allows half an hour in most cases one hour exceptionally for a very important case.
generally	In most cases; usually. A decade when France was moving generally to the left.
habitually	According to habit or custom. He habitually carried a pocket knife.
irresistibly	In a way that is too attractive and tempting to be resisted. Men are irresistibly attracted to her.
<u>largely</u>	On a large scale. He was soon arrested largely through the efforts of Tom Poole.
<u>mainly</u>	For the most part. The west will be mainly dry.
<u>mostly</u>	Usually; generally. The culprits are mostly but not exclusively male.
<u>normally</u>	In a normal manner. Normally it takes three or four years to complete the training.



ordinarily	Under normal conditions. An effort to behave ordinarily .
<u>originally</u>	In a novel and inventive way. Potatoes originally came from South America.
pantechnicon	A large moving van (especially one used for moving furniture.
predominantly	Much greater in number or influence. The patients are predominantly indigenous.
primarily	For the most part. This is primarily a question of economics.
principal	An actor who plays a principal role. I was appointed principal of the new school.
principally	For the most part; chiefly. <i>He was principally a landscape painter.</i>
<u>public</u>	Affecting the people or community as a whole. <i>Performers and members of royal families are public figures.</i>
<u>routinely</u>	As part of a regular procedure rather than for a special reason. Large scale producers routinely vaccinate their birds against the disease.
<u>specially</u>	In a special manner. A specially commissioned report.
typically	In most cases; usually. <i>Typically</i> masculine social roles.
universally	Everywhere. Progress is not always universally welcomed.
usually	Under normal conditions. He usually arrives home about one o clock.
<u>wont</u>	An established custom. He was wont to arise at 5 30 every morning.
