Synonyms of "Overzealous" as an adjective (11 Words)

extreme	Not usual; exceptional. <i>Extreme</i> temperatures.
<u>extremist</u>	(used of opinions and actions) far beyond the norm. <i>Extremist political views.</i>
fanatic	Marked by excessive enthusiasm for and intense devotion to a cause or idea. <i>His eyes had a fanatic iciness.</i>
fanatical	Marked by excessive enthusiasm for and intense devotion to a cause or idea. <i>Her husband was fanatical about tidiness.</i>
<u>fervent</u>	Hot, burning, or glowing. A fervent admirer.



<u>maniacal</u>	Exhibiting extremely wild or violent behaviour. John burst into maniacal laughter.
passionate	Arising from intense feelings of sexual love. A passionate kiss.
<u>rabid</u>	Having or proceeding from an extreme or fanatical support of or belief in something. <i>The show s small but rabid fan base.</i>
uncompromising	Harsh or relentless. Uncompromising honesty.
violent	Marked by extreme intensity of emotions or convictions inclined to react violently fervid. <i>A violent</i> clash of colors.
wild	Produced from wild animals or plants without cultivation. A wild stretch of land.
