# **Conjugate Paggle**

#### **Paggle in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>paggle</b>	We <b>paggle</b>
You <b>paggle</b>	You <b>paggle</b>
He/She/It paggles	They paggle

#### **Paggle in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>am paggling</b>	We <b>are paggling</b>
You <b>are paggling</b>	You <b>are paggling</b>
He/She/It is paggling	They are paggling

#### **Paggle in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have paggled	We have paggled
You <b>have paggled</b>	You have paggled
He/She/It has paggled	They have paggled

### **Paggle in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been paggling	We have been paggling
You <b>have been paggling</b>	You have been paggling
He/She/It has been paggling	They have been paggling

#### Paggle in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>paggled</b>	We <b>paggled</b>
You <b>paggled</b>	You <b>paggled</b>
He/She/It <b>paggled</b>	They <b>paggled</b>

#### **Paggle in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was paggling	We <b>were paggling</b>
You <b>were paggling</b>	You were paggling
He/She/It was paggling	They were paggling

#### **Paggle in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had paggled	We had paggled
You <b>had paggled</b>	You had paggled
He/She/It had paggled	They had paggled

#### **Paggle in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been paggling	We had been paggling
You <b>had been paggling</b>	You <b>had been paggling</b>
He/She/It had been paggling	They had been paggling

## Paggle in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will paggle</b>	We <b>will paggle</b>
You <b>will paggle</b>	You <b>will paggle</b>
He/She/It will paggle	They will paggle

### **Paggle in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be paggling	We <b>will be paggling</b>
You <b>will be paggling</b>	You <b>will be paggling</b>
He/She/It will be paggling	They will be paggling

I will have been paggling	We <b>will have been paggling</b>
