According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “painting” as a noun can have the following definitions:

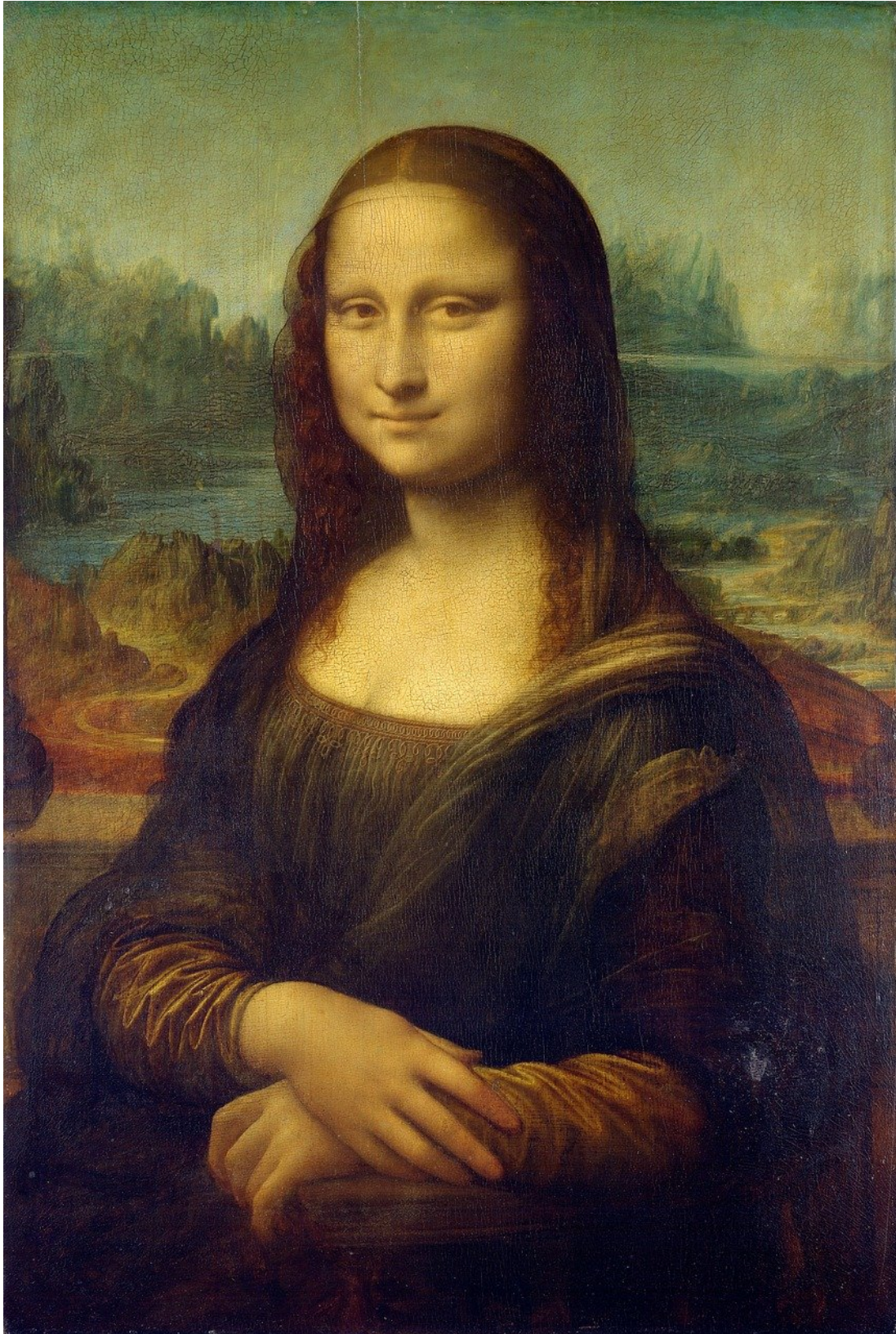
- *A painted picture.*

- *Graphic art consisting of an artistic composition made by applying paints to a surface.*
- *The action or skill of using paint, either in a picture or as decoration.*



Synonyms of "Painting" as a noun (12 Words)

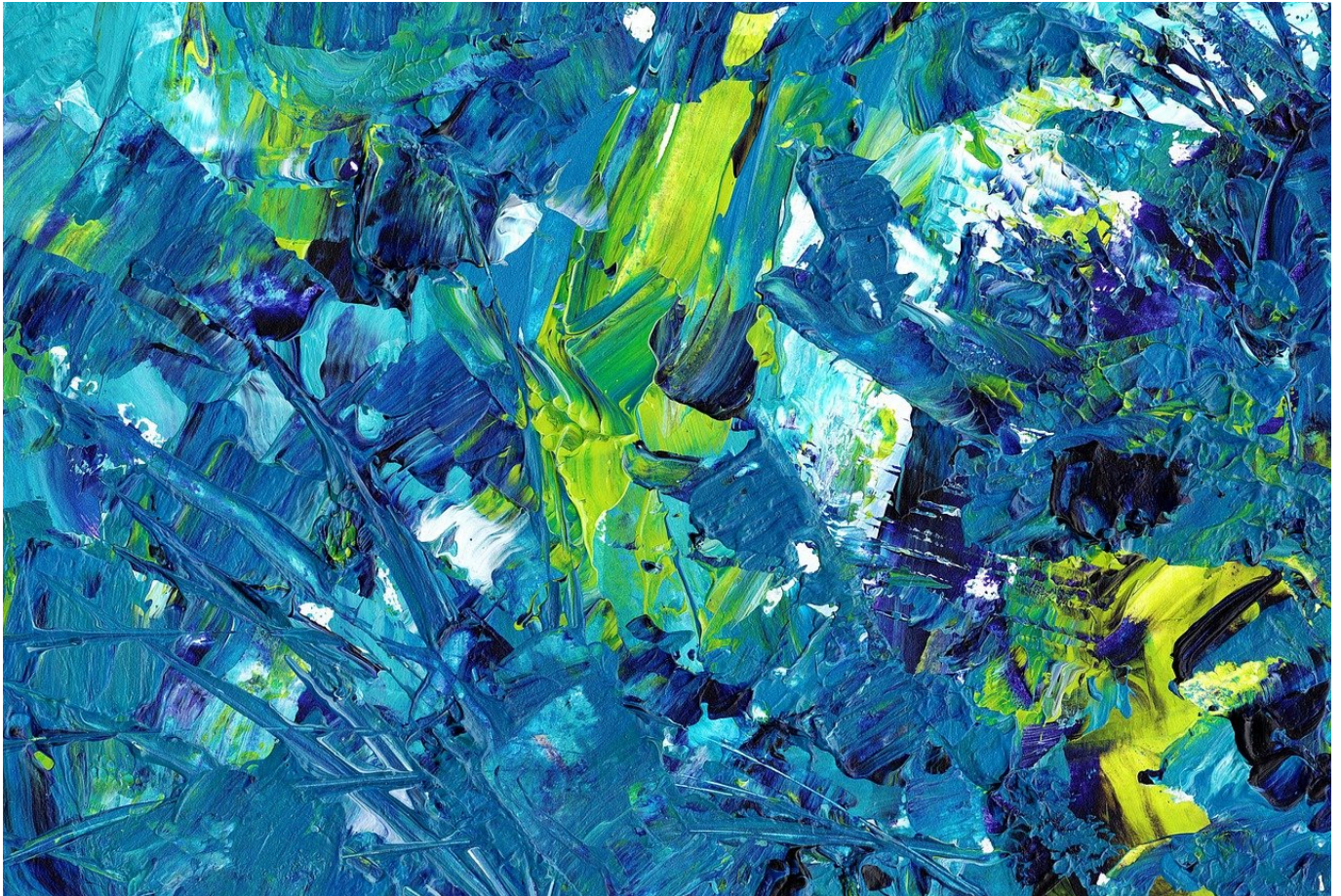
- artwork** Photographs or other visual representations in a printed publication.
*The publisher was responsible for all the **artwork** in the book.*
- cartoon** A film made by photographing a series of cartoon drawings to give the illusion of movement when projected in rapid sequence.
***Cartoon** characters.*
- delineation** A graphic or vivid verbal description.
*The eventual **delineation** of the border between the two states.*
- depiction** The action of depicting something, especially in a work of art.
*Michelangelo's **depictions** of the male nude.*
- house painting** One of 12 equal areas into which the zodiac is divided.
- illustration** The action or fact of illustrating something.
*An **illustration** of a yacht.*

likeness	<p>Similarity in appearance or character or nature between persons or things.</p> <p><i>Humans are described as being made in God s likeness.</i></p>
picture	<p>A situation treated as an observable object.</p> <p><i>He had no clear picture of himself or his world.</i></p>
portrayal	<p>A representation by picture or portraiture.</p> <p><i>A realistic portrayal of war.</i></p>
representation	<p>Formal statements made to an authority, especially so as to communicate an opinion or register a protest.</p> <p><i>You may qualify for free legal representation.</i></p>
sketch	<p>A brief written or spoken account or description, giving only basic details.</p> <p><i>You can see how the first movement evolved from the composer s sketches.</i></p>

<u>artistic</u>	Relating to or characteristic of art or artists. <i>Computer programs which produce artistic designs.</i>
<u>canvas</u>	Either of a racing boat s tapering ends originally covered with canvas. <i>He is used to painting large canvases.</i>
chiaroscuro	The treatment of light and shade in drawing and painting. <i>The chiaroscuro of cobbled streets.</i>
cinematic	Of or pertaining to or characteristic of the cinema. <i>Cinematic output.</i>
<u>collage</u>	The art of making collages. <i>He used his computer to make a collage of pictures superimposed on a map.</i>
coloring	A digestible substance used to give color to food.
<u>drawing</u>	The act of moving a load by drawing or pulling. <i>The drawing of water from the well.</i>
fresco	Paint in fresco. <i>Four scenes had been frescoed on the wall.</i>
gouache	Opaque watercolour of the type used in gouache painting.
graffiti	Write or draw graffiti on something. <i>The station was covered in graffiti.</i>
<u>graph</u>	Plot or trace on a graph.
gymnast	An athlete who is skilled in gymnastics.
illustrator	A person who draws or creates pictures for magazines, books, advertising, etc.
<u>masterpiece</u>	The most outstanding work of a creative artist or craftsman. <i>A great literary masterpiece.</i>
<u>mosaic</u>	Decorate with a mosaic. <i>The walls and vaults are decorated by marble and mosaic.</i>
mural	Relating to or occurring in the wall of a body cavity or blood vessel. <i>Huge murals depicting Norse legends.</i>
<u>paint</u>	Make a painting. <i>He Painted all day in the garden.</i>
photography	The occupation of taking and printing photographs or making movies.
picture	Show in or as in a picture. <i>They showed us the pictures of their wedding.</i>

pigment	Color or dye with a pigment. <i>Artists use paint and pigment interchangeably.</i>
plywood	A laminate made of thin layers of wood. <i>Plywood benches.</i>
poster	Put up posters in an area. <i>A poster campaign.</i>
scrawl	An example of hurried, careless writing. <i>Charlie scrawled his signature.</i>
subculture	A cultural group within a larger culture, often having beliefs or interests at variance with those of the larger culture. <i>In what ways does the social environment predispose certain individuals to join delinquent subcultures.</i>
tasteful	Free from what is tawdry or unbecoming. <i>A tasteful lounge bar.</i>
triptych	A picture or relief carving on three panels, typically hinged together vertically and used as an altarpiece. <i>A triptych depicting the Crucifixion.</i>
vandalism	Action involving deliberate destruction of or damage to public or private property. <i>An act of mindless vandalism.</i>
