- bikini briefs** A condensed written summary or abstract.
- bloomers** Underpants worn by women.  
*She was afraid that her **bloomers** might have been showing.*
- boxer shorts** Underpants worn by men.
- boxers** Underpants worn by men.
- briefs** Short, close-fitting underpants or knickers.  
*A pair of blue **briefs**.*
- defective** A person with mental disabilities.
- drawers** An artist skilled at drawing.
- imperfect** The imperfect tense.
- inferior** An inferior letter figure or symbol.  
*Her social and intellectual **inferiors**.*

<b>knickers</b>	Trousers ending above the knee. <i>Oh <b>knickers</b> to the lot of them.</i>
<b>poor</b>	People without possessions or wealth (considered as a group). <i>The urban <b>poor</b> need assistance.</i>
<b><u>shoddy</u></b>	An inferior quality yarn or fabric made from the shredded fibre of waste woollen cloth or clippings. <i>The production of <b>shoddy</b> and mattress stuffing.</i>
<b>slacks</b>	The quality of being loose (not taut).
<b>trousers</b>	An outer garment covering the body from the waist to the ankles, with a separate part for each leg. <i>He had a sharp crease in his <b>trousers</b>.</i>
<b>underpants</b>	An undergarment, especially for men or boys, covering the lower part of the torso and having two holes for the legs.



### Usage Examples of "Pants" as a noun

- *He thought we were going to be absolute pants.*

- *Wide pant legs.*
- *Corduroy pants.*



## Associations of "Pants" (30 Words)

<b>blouse</b>	A loose linen or cotton garment formerly worn by peasants and manual workers, typically belted at the waist. <i>I <b>bloused</b> my trousers over my boots.</i>
<b>bodice</b>	The close-fitting upper part of a dress, covering the chest and back above the waist.
<b>cape</b>	In bullfighting taunt the bull by flourishing a cape. <i>The robe was decorated with gold lace on the fronts <b>cape</b> and hem.</i>
<b>chiffon</b>	(of a cake or dessert) made with beaten egg to give a light consistency. <i><b>Chiffon</b> cake.</i>
<b>corset</b>	Dress with a corset.

<b>dress</b>	Put a dressing on. <i>He <b>dressed</b> up in a suit and tie.</i>
<b>garment</b>	An item of clothing. <i>A windproof outer <b>garment</b>.</i>
<b>gown</b>	Dress in a gown. <i>She was <b>gowned</b> in luminous silk.</i>
<b>hat</b>	Headdress that protects the head from bad weather has shaped crown and usually a brim. <i>He was unsuitably <b>hatted</b>.</i>
<b>headdress</b>	An ornamental covering or band for the head, especially one worn on ceremonial occasions. <i>A veil held in place with a pearl <b>headdress</b>.</i>
<b>hoop</b>	Bind or encircle with or as with hoops. <i>A woman in <b>hoops</b> and crinoline.</i>
<b>hosiery</b>	Stockings, socks, and tights collectively.
<b>jacket</b>	A jacket potato. <i>He put his hand in his <b>jacket</b> pocket.</i>
<b>jean</b>	Heavy twilled cotton cloth, especially denim. <i>A <b>jean</b> jacket.</i>
<b>loincloth</b>	A single piece of cloth wrapped round the hips, typically worn by men in some hot countries as their only garment.
<b>pleat</b>	Pleat or gather into a ruffle. <i>She was absently <b>pleating</b> her skirt between her fingers.</i>
<b>robe</b>	A dressing gown or bathrobe. <i>I went into the vestry and <b>robed</b> for the Mass.</i>
<b>scarf</b>	Wrap in or adorn with a scarf. <i>A silk <b>scarf</b>.</i>
<b>shirt</b>	Put a shirt on. <i>Smith increased his chances of a Great Britain <b>shirt</b> with a penalty shot save.</i>
<b>shorts</b>	Men's underpants. <i>Cycling <b>shorts</b>.</i>
<b>skirt</b>	A cut of meat from the lower flank. <i>The river valley <b>skirts</b> along the northern slopes of the hills.</i>
<b>sleeve</b>	A protective paper or cardboard cover for a record, CD, or DVD. <i>A shirt with the <b>sleeves</b> rolled up.</i>

<b>sweater</b>	A person who perspires. <i>A close knit wool <b>sweater</b> for icy weather.</i>
<b>sweatshirt</b>	A loose, warm sweater, typically made of cotton, worn when exercising or as leisurewear.
<b>swimsuit</b>	A woman's one-piece swimming costume.
<b>undergarment</b>	An article of underclothing.
<b>undershirt</b>	A collarless men's undergarment for the upper part of the body.
<b>underwear</b>	Undergarment worn next to the skin and under the outer garments.
<b>vest</b>	Of a chorister or member of the clergy put on vestments. <i>A bulletproof <b>vest</b>.</i>
<b>wear</b>	The wearing of something or the state of being worn as clothing. <i><b>Wear</b> one's hair in a certain way.</i>
