- *The abode of righteous souls after death.*
- *(in some religions) heaven as the ultimate abode of the just.*
- *An ideal or idyllic place or state.*
- *(Christianity) the abode of righteous souls after death.*
- *Any place of complete bliss and delight and peace.*



## Synonyms of "Paradise" as a noun (24 Words)

**abraham's bosom** A close affectionate and protective acceptance.

**bliss** A state of extreme happiness.  
*The **bliss** of heaven.*

**delight** A feeling of extreme pleasure or satisfaction.  
*The new car is a **delight**.*

**ecstasy** An amphetamine-based recreational drug having euphoric effects, typically taken in the form of a pill and particularly associated with clubbing and dance music subcultures.  
*There was a look of **ecstasy** on his face.*

**eden** A beautiful garden where Adam and Eve were placed at the Creation; when they disobeyed and ate the forbidden fruit from the tree of knowledge of good and evil they were driven from their paradise (the fall of man).

**fairyland** Something existing solely in the imagination (but often mistaken for reality).  
*This can seem like **fairyland** in our kind of violent world.*

<b>happiness</b>	State of well-being characterized by emotions ranging from contentment to intense joy. <i>Tom s heart swelled with <b>happiness</b>.</i>
<b>heaven</b>	A place regarded in various religions as the abode of God (or the gods) and the angels, and of the good after death, often traditionally depicted as being above the sky. <i>Those who practised good deeds would receive the reward of a place in <b>heaven</b>.</i>
<b>heaven on earth</b>	The abode of God and the angels.
<b>idyll</b>	An episode of such pastoral or romantic charm as to qualify as the subject of a poetic idyll. <i>The rural <b>idyll</b> remains strongly evocative in most industrialized societies.</i>
<b>joy</b>	A thing that causes joy. <i>Tears of <b>joy</b>.</i>
<b>nirvana</b>	An ideal or idyllic state or place. <i>The days of socialist <b>nirvana</b> in Europe are over.</i>
<b>promised land</b>	Grounds for feeling hopeful about the future.
<b>rapture</b>	Expressions of intense pleasure or enthusiasm about something. <i>The tabloids went into <b>raptures</b> about her.</i>
<b>seventh heaven</b>	Position seven in a countable series of things.
<b>shangri-la</b>	Any place of complete bliss and delight and peace.
<b>the abode of god</b>	Any address at which you dwell more than temporarily.
<b>the abode of the saints</b>	Any address at which you dwell more than temporarily.
<b>the city of god</b>	People living in a large densely populated municipality.
<b>the garden of eden</b>	A yard or lawn adjoining a house.
<b>the kingdom of heaven</b>	A domain in which something is dominant.
<b>the promised land</b>	Grounds for feeling hopeful about the future.
<b>utopia</b>	A work of fiction describing a utopia. <i>Misplaced faith in political <b>utopias</b> has led to ruin.</i>
<b>zion</b>	An imaginary place considered to be perfect or ideal.

<b>angel</b>	In traditional Christian angelology a being of the lowest order of the ninefold celestial hierarchy. <i>The longer it takes you to get your product into the marketplace the longer it will be until the <b>angels</b> get their money back.</i>
<b>angelic</b>	Relating to angels. <i>The <b>angelic</b> hosts.</i>
<b>ascension</b>	The ascent of Christ into heaven on the fortieth day after the Resurrection. <i>His <b>ascension</b> to the presidency.</i>
<b>celestial</b>	Belonging or relating to heaven. <i><b>Celestial</b> map.</i>
<b>christian</b>	A religious person who believes Jesus is the Christ and who is a member of a Christian denomination.
<b>disbelieve</b>	Have no religious faith. <i>To <b>disbelieve</b> is as much an act of faith as belief.</i>
<b>divine</b>	Resulting from divine providence. <i>Paintings of shipwrecks being prevented by <b>divine</b> intervention.</i>
<b>dreamer</b>	Someone who is dreaming. <i>A rebellious young <b>dreamer</b>.</i>
<b>elysian</b>	Relating to the Elysian Fields. <i>An <b>elysian</b> meal.</i>

<b><u>ethereal</u></b>	Of or containing or dissolved in ether. <i><b>Ethereal</b> melodies.</i>
<b>firmament</b>	The heavens or sky. <i>Thunder shakes the <b>firmament</b>.</i>
<b>heaven</b>	A state of being eternally in the presence of God after death. <i>Lying by the pool with a good book is my idea of <b>heaven</b>.</i>
<b><u>heavenly</u></b>	Of the heavens or sky. <i><b>Heavenly</b> constellations.</i>
<b>idealistic</b>	Of high moral or intellectual value; elevated in nature or style. <i><b>Idealistic</b> young doctors who went to work for the rebels.</i>
<b>immortality</b>	The quality or state of being immortal. <i>Occasionally a guide book has achieved <b>immortality</b>.</i>
<b>nirvana</b>	The beatitude that transcends the cycle of reincarnation; characterized by the extinction of desire and suffering and individual consciousness. <i>The days of socialist <b>nirvana</b> in Europe are over.</i>
<b>omnipotent</b>	Having great power and influence. <i>God is described as <b>omnipotent</b> and benevolent.</i>
<b>omniscience</b>	The state of knowing everything. <i>His reputation for near <b>omniscience</b> and infallibility.</i>
<b>orison</b>	A prayer.
<b><u>resurrection</u></b>	The revitalization or revival of something. <i>The story of the <b>resurrection</b> of Osiris.</i>
<b>resuscitated</b>	Restored to life or consciousness.
<b>sacred</b>	(of writing or text) embodying the laws or doctrines of a religion. <i>Cows are <b>sacred</b> and the eating of beef is taboo.</i>
<b>saintly</b>	Marked by utter benignity; resembling or befitting an angel or saint. <i>A <b>saintly</b> concern for his fellow men.</i>
<b>soul</b>	The immaterial part of a person; the actuating cause of an individual life. <i>Brevity is the <b>soul</b> of wit.</i>
<b><u>sublime</u></b>	Cause a substance to sublime. <i>Mozart's <b>sublime</b> piano concertos.</i>
<b>supernal</b>	Of exceptional quality or extent. <i>He is the <b>supernal</b> poet of our age.</i>
<b><u>utopia</u></b>	A work of fiction describing a utopia. <i>Misplaced faith in political <b>utopias</b> has led to ruin.</i>
<b>welkin</b>	The apparent surface of the imaginary sphere on which celestial bodies appear to be projected.
