Infinitive	<b>to parallel</b>
Present Tense	<b>parallel / parallels</b>
Past Tense	<b>paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>
Present Participle	<b>paralleling or parallelled (british only)</b>
Past Participle	<b>paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **parallel**

We **parallel**

You **parallel**

You **parallel**

He/She/It **parallels**

They **parallel**

## **Parallel in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

We **are paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

You **are paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

You **are paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

He/She/It **is paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

They **are paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

## **Parallel in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have paralleled or paralleled (british only)**

We **have paralleled or paralleled (british only)**

You **have paralleled or paralleled (british only)**

He/She/It **has paralleled or paralleled (british only)**

They **have paralleled or paralleled (british only)**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

We **have been paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

You **have been paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

You **have been paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

He/She/It **has been paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

They **have been paralleling or paralleling (british only)**

## **Parallel in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>	<b>We paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>
<b>You paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>	<b>You paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>
<b>He/She/It paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>	<b>They paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>

## **Parallel in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I was paralleling or parallelling (british only)</b>	<b>We were paralleling or parallelling (british only)</b>
<b>You were paralleling or parallelling (british only)</b>	<b>You were paralleling or parallelling (british only)</b>
<b>He/She/It was paralleling or parallelling (british only)</b>	<b>They were paralleling or parallelling (british only)</b>

## **Parallel in Past Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I had paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>	<b>We had paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>
<b>You had paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>	<b>You had paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>
<b>He/She/It had paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>	<b>They had paralleled or parallelled (british only)</b>

## **Parallel in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I had been paralleling or parallelling (british only)</b>	<b>We had been paralleling or parallelling (british only)</b>
<b>You had been paralleling or parallelling (british only)</b>	<b>You had been paralleling or parallelling (british only)</b>

**Singular**

He/She/It **had been paralleling or parallelling (british only)**

**Plural**

They **had been paralleling or parallelling (british only)**

**Parallel in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

I **will parallel**

You **will parallel**

He/She/It **will parallel**

**Plural**

We **will parallel**

You **will parallel**

They **will parallel**

**Parallel in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I **will be paralleling or parallelling (british only)**

You **will be paralleling or parallelling (british only)**

He/She/It **will be paralleling or parallelling (british only)**

**Plural**

We **will be paralleling or parallelling (british only)**
