## The Forms of Parallel

Infinitive to parallel

Present Tense parallel / parallels

Past Tense paralleled or parallelled (british only)
Present Participle paralleling or parallelling (british only)
Past Participle paralleled or parallelled (british only)

# **Conjugate Parallel**

Parallel in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I parallel We parallel
You parallel You parallel
He/She/It parallels They parallel

## Parallel in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am paralleling or parallelling (british only)

You are paralleling or parallelling (british only)

You are paralleling or parallelling (british only)

He/She/It is paralleling or parallelling (british only)

They are paralleling or parallelling (british only)

### Parallel in Present Perfect Tense

I have paralleled or parallelled (british only)

You have paralleled or parallelled (british only)

You have paralleled or parallelled (british only)

He/She/It has paralleled or parallelled (british only)

They have paralleled or parallelled (british only)

#### Parallel in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I have been paralleling or parallelling (british only)

You have been paralleling or parallelling (british only)

You have been paralleling or parallelling (british only)

He/She/It has been paralleling or parallelling or parallelling (british only)

They have been paralleling or parallelling (british only)



# Parallel in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I paralleled or parallelled (british only)	We paralleled or parallelled (british only)
You paralleled or parallelled (british only)	You paralleled or parallelled (british only)
He/She/It paralleled or parallelled (british only)	They paralleled or parallelled (british only)

# Parallel in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I was paralleling or parallelling (british only)	We were paralleling or parallelling (british only)
You were paralleling or parallelling (british only)	You were paralleling or parallelling (british only)
He/She/It was paralleling or parallelling (british only)	They were paralleling or parallelling (british only)

## **Parallel in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had paralleled or parallelled (british only)	We had paralleled or parallelled (british only)
You had paralleled or parallelled (british only)	You had paralleled or parallelled (british only)
He/She/It had paralleled or parallelled (british only)	They had paralleled or parallelled (british only)

## **Parallel in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been paralleling or parallelling (british only)	We had been paralleling or parallelling (british only)
You had been paralleling or parallelling (british only)	You had been paralleling or parallelling (british only)



**Singular** 

Plural

He/She/It had been paralleling or paralleling (british only)

They had been paralleling or parallelling (british only)

### Parallel in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will parallel We will parallel
You will parallel You will parallel
He/She/It will parallel They will parallel

### Parallel in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be paralleling or parallelling We will be paralleling or parallelling

(british only) (british only)

You will be paralleling or parallelling You will be paralleling or parallelling

(british only) (british only)

He/She/It will be paralleling or They will be paralleling or parallelling

parallelling (british only) (british only)

### **Parallel in Future Perfect Tense**

Singular Plural

I will have paralleled or parallelled We will have paralleled or parallelled

(british only) (british only)

You will have paralleled or parallelled You will have paralleled or parallelled

(british only) (british only)

He/She/It will have paralleled or They will have paralleled or paralleled

parallelled (british only) (british only)

### **Parallel in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I will have been paralleling or We will have been paralleling or

parallelling (british only) parallelling (british only)



## Singular

You will have been paralleling or paralleling (british only)
He/She/It will have been paralleling or paralleling (british only)

### Plural

You will have been paralleling or parallelling (british only)
They will have been paralleling or parallelling (british only)
