## Parse as a Verb

### Definitions of "Parse" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “parse” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Analyze syntactically by assigning a constituent structure to (a sentence).*
- *Resolve (a sentence) into its component parts and describe their syntactic roles.*
- *Analyse (a string or text) into logical syntactic components.*



## Synonyms of "Parse" as a verb (12 Words)

<b>analyse</b>	Psychoanalyse someone. <i>We need to <b>analyse</b> our results more clearly.</i>
<b>decode</b>	Convert (a coded message) into intelligible language. <i>Processors used to <b>decode</b> CD quality digital audio signals.</i>
<b>elucidate</b>	Make free from confusion or ambiguity; make clear. <i>In what follows I shall try to <b>elucidate</b> what I believe the problems to be.</i>
<b>explain</b>	Be the cause of or motivating factor for. <i>They <b>explained</b> that their lives centred on the religious rituals.</i>
<b>gloss</b>	Give a shine or gloss to usually by rubbing. <i>The singer <b>glossed</b> her lips a deep red.</i>
<b>interpret</b>	Give an interpretation or explanation to. <i>I agreed to <b>interpret</b> for Jean Claude.</i>
<b>read</b>	Habitually read a particular newspaper or periodical. <i>For madam <b>read</b> madman.</i>
<b>render</b>	Give up surrender. <i>They had to <b>render</b> the estate.</i>
<b>see</b>	Go to see a place as for entertainment. <i>Elements are usually classified as metals or non metals <b>see</b> chapter 11.</i>
<b>take</b>	Take on a certain form attribute or aspect. <i>Some people found her hard to <b>take</b>.</i>
<b>take to mean</b>	Take by force.
<b>understand</b>	Be understanding of. <i>I <b>understand</b> how you feel.</i>

## Usage Examples of "Parse" as a verb

- *I asked a couple of students to parse these sentences for me.*
- *A user question input is parsed into an internal conceptual representation.*

## Associations of "Parse" (30 Words)

<b>alliterate</b>	(of a phrase or line of verse) contain words which begin with the same sound or letter. <i>His first and last names <b>alliterated</b>.</i>
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<b>alphabet</b>	A character set that includes letters and is used to write a language. <i>A phonetic <b>alphabet</b>.</i>
<b>analyze</b>	Break down into components or essential features. <i><b>Analyze</b> a sentence.</i>
<b>antonym</b>	A word that expresses a meaning opposed to the meaning of another word in which case the two words are antonyms of each other. <i>To him the <b>antonym</b> of gay was depressed.</i>
<b>apostrophe</b>	The mark (') used to indicate the omission of one or more letters from a printed word.
<b>bewitchment</b>	A magical spell.
<b>collocation</b>	A pair or group of words that are habitually juxtaposed. <i>The words have a similar range of <b>collocation</b>.</i>
<b>correction</b>	Punishment, especially that of criminals in prison intended to rectify their behaviour. <i>The incompatibility of justice and <b>correction</b> as penal objectives has long been the major unsolved problem of penal practice.</i>
<b>grammar</b>	A book on grammar. <i>Chomskyan <b>grammar</b>.</i>
<b>grammarian</b>	A linguist who specializes in the study of grammar and syntax.
<b>homonym</b>	Two words are homonyms if they are pronounced or spelled the same way but have different meanings.
<b><u>indent</u></b>	A space left by indenting text. <i>We were <b>indenting</b> for paper clips one by one in those days.</i>
<b>indentation</b>	A deep recess or notch on the edge or surface of something. <i>Coastal <b>indentations</b>.</i>
<b><u>juxtaposition</u></b>	A side-by-side position. <i>The <b>juxtaposition</b> of these two images.</i>
<b>litotes</b>	Understatement for rhetorical effect (especially when expressing an affirmative by negating its contrary). <i>Saying I was not a little upset when you mean I was very upset is an example of <b>litotes</b>.</i>
<b><u>morphology</u></b>	A particular form, shape, or structure. <i>Grammar is organized along two main dimensions <b>morphology</b> and syntax.</i>
<b>orthography</b>	The study of spelling and how letters combine to represent sounds and form words. <i>A spoken language which has as yet no sanctioned <b>orthography</b>.</i>

<b>paragraph</b>	Divide into paragraphs as of text. <i>All her friends were <b>paragraphed</b> in last Monday s paper.</i>
<b>phrase</b>	Divide combine or mark into phrases. <i>They <b>phrased</b> the music with gusto.</i>
<b>punctuation</b>	The marks, such as full stop, comma, and brackets, used in writing to separate sentences and their elements and to clarify meaning. <i>Satisfactory standards of handwriting spelling grammar and <b>punctuation</b>.</i>
<b>quotation</b>	A registration granted to a company enabling their shares to be officially listed and traded. <i>A <b>quotation</b> from Mark Twain.</i>
<b><u>rhetoric</u></b>	Language designed to have a persuasive or impressive effect, but which is often regarded as lacking in sincerity or meaningful content. <i>Mere <b>rhetoric</b>.</i>
<b>sentence</b>	Pronounce a sentence on somebody in a court of law. <i>He always spoke in grammatical <b>sentences</b>.</i>
<b><u>spelling</u></b>	The way a word is spelled. <i>Her <b>spelling</b> was deplorable.</i>
<b><u>syntax</u></b>	The branch of linguistics that deals with syntax. <i>Generative <b>syntax</b>.</i>
<b>typo</b>	A typographical error.
<b>typographic</b>	Relating to or occurring or used in typography. <i>The <b>typographic</b> art.</i>
<b>ungrammatical</b>	Not conforming to grammatical rules. <i><b>Ungrammatical</b> sentences.</i>
<b>vocabulary</b>	The words used in a particular subject or sphere of activity or on a particular occasion. <i>The term became part of business <b>vocabulary</b>.</i>
<b>word</b>	The divine word of God the second person in the Trinity incarnate in Jesus. <i>He hardly said ten <b>words</b> all morning.</i>
